There have been concerns regarding
Sitting vehicles.

Junk Vehicle's,
No person shall cause or permit any junked vehicles to be kept on any land owned by that person.

A junked vehicle is defined as a vehicle that:

- Has no valid license plates attached to it: or
- Is in a rusted, wrecked, dismantled, inoperative, or abandoned condition; and
- Does not form a part of a business enterprise lawfully being operated on private land and where

Three (3) or more vehicles are being parked or stored on that land, but not being screened entirely from public view or wholly contained within a lawfully existing structure erected in accordance with any Bylaw respecting the erection of the buildings and structures in force within the municipality.
