
Gravel pit sought in Cambridge near U.S. 12

Property owners are exploring the possibility of starting a gravel mining operation in Cambridge Township, say officials.

The township received a change of zoning request from SSP Leasing in Dansville to establish a gravel mining operation on property formerly known as the Brighton Farm. The gravel operation would be located on property south of U.S. 12 between Allen and Kelley lakes.

SSP Leasing owns Sunshine Products, a retail landscape supply company, also located in Dansville. Company officials did not return a phone call from the Exponent to discuss their plans.

A preliminary review of the application will be held by the township planning commission on October 26 at 7 p.m. at the township hall. The planning commission will then make a recommendation to the township board as to approve or deny the request.
