The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (the Service) has received your request for input regarding the information you provided on a tract in Cambridge Township, Lenawee County, Michigan. You requested the Services' review and determination regarding the United States' interest in lands covered by a Farm Service Agency Conservation Easement Reservation transferred to the Service in 1996. The property is managed on behalf of the United States by the Fish and Wildlife Service and is known as tract 562C.

We have reviewed the Application for Conditional Use Permit submitted by SSP Leasing and multiple maps including aerial photography, topography, and a survey depicting the conservation easement areas you provided. We have also reviewed the conservation easement you provided and the Fish and Wildlife Service's information on this tract. The Fish and Wildlife Service has determined mining activities are prohibited by the restrictions in the recorded conservation easement.
