

Quarry Ordinance Amendment Public Hearing

The Purpose of the Public Hearing is for the public's input on a request from the Cambridge Township Planning Commission for a revision to Section 36-410 of the Cambridge Township Zoning Ordinance regarding Quarries. The intent is to replace the current ordinance with Section 36-410 Mineral Mining. This section would also reference a new stand-alone Mining Control Ordinance which will be a general Township Ordinance still in review by the Township Board.

Administrivia: Hearing is Hybrid Zoom. In Zoom it will be viewing only. No Public Comment in Zoom. The Committee will not be making a motion or voting during the Public Hearing. If a motion and vote does occur it will take place during the Regular Meeting. A motion or vote does not necessarily occur the day of the Public Hearing. An additional meeting(s) may be required if the Planning Commission chooses. When a motion and vote does occur the result is a recommendation sent Region 2 for their recommendation. Both recommendations then go to the Township Board. The final decision is made by the Township Board at their meeting.

Doug Lewan from Carlisle Wartman and Attorneys representing Cambridge Township will present the proposed Ordinance.
