# **Bylaws for Improving Lives**

# **Article I: Name and Purpose**

#### Section 1: Name

The name of this organization shall be "Improving Lives."

#### Section 2: Purpose

Improving Lives is a mission-driven organization dedicated to empowering Black and Brown communities to address systemic discrimination and injustice through education and legal measures assistance, community support, and advocacy programs.

# **Article II: Mission and Vision**

#### **Section 1: Mission Statement**

Improving Lives strives to empower Black and Brown communities to overcome systemic discrimination and injustice while advocating for dignity, respect, and equal rights for all individuals.

#### Section 2: Vision Statement

Improving Lives envisions a world where Black and Brown communities flourish in a society free from discrimination and inequality, nurturing empowerment, justice, and mutual respect.

# **Article III: Core Values**

- 1. Equity: Ensuring access to opportunities and resources for all.
- 2. Empowerment: Helping individuals and communities take control of their futures.
- 3. Justice: Advocating for systemic changes that foster a just society.
- 4. Collaboration: Partnering with communities and organizations to achieve shared goals.
- 5. **Respect**: Valuing the dignity of every individual.

# **Article IV: Membership**

#### Section 1: Eligibility

Membership is available to individuals and organizations that support Improving Lives' mission and values.

#### **Section 2: Membership Rights**

Members may engage in all activities, vote on organizational matters, and receive updates on programs and initiatives.

### **Article V: Governance**

#### Section 1: Leadership Team

- The Leadership Team will consist of **the CEO**, who oversees the overall strategy and operations.
- Business Director: Oversees finances, partnerships, and growth.
- Director of Affairs: Coordinates programs and outreach efforts.
- Communications Manager: Directs public relations and marketing efforts.
- National Political Strategies: Formulate advocacy strategies.
- Legal Counsel: Offers legal advice.

#### **Section 2: Youth Leadership**

A Youth Council Committee will ensure that the voices of youth are included in decisionmaking.

### **Article VI: Meetings**

#### **Section 1: Regular Meetings**

The organization shall hold regular meetings at least quarterly to discuss ongoing programs, financial status, and strategic planning.

#### **Section 2: Special Meetings**

Special meetings may be called by the CEO or a majority of the Leadership Team as necessary.

### **Article VII: Financial Management**

#### **Section 1: Revenue Streams**

The organization shall fund its programs through grants, donations, sponsorships, and merchandise sales.

#### Section 2: Fiscal Year

The organization's fiscal year shall be from January 1 to December 31.

#### Section 3: Budget

The Leadership Team shall prepare an annual budget to be approved by the membership.

## **Article VIII: Amendments**

#### **Section 1: Procedure**

A two-thirds majority vote of the membership present at a regular meeting may amend these bylaws.

#### **Section 2: Notification**

Members must be notified of proposed amendments at least two weeks prior to the meeting.

## **Article IX: Dissolution**

In the event of dissolution, any remaining assets shall be distributed to organizations with similar purposes, as determined by the Leadership Team.

These bylaws are established to guide Improving Lives' operations and governance, ensuring alignment with our mission to empower Black and Brown communities.
