Community Leaders Demand Justice for Allentown City Employees

ALLENTOWN, PA – A press conference will be held on **Saturday, May 10, 2025, at 2 PM** at the **MLK Jr. & Coretta Scott King statue**, adjacent to **St. James AME Zion Church**, 410 W. Union St., Allentown, to address the ongoing injustices faced by city employees working under so-called “plantation” working conditions. This event seeks to inform Allentown taxpayers about misleading statements made by Mayor Matt Tuerk, his administration, and several city council members regarding the management of public funds.

The press conference will present critical evidence supporting the need to continue the **independent investigation** led by former FBI investigator Scott Curtis. Community leaders and affected employees will share their experiences and insights, underscoring the urgent need for transparency and accountability in local government.
