

"The Salvation Rosary"

(Believed to be inspired and revealed by Saint John Paul II and through the influence of the "Miracle Lady of Costa Rica", a friend of Joseph Maurizio) (Praying the Salvation Rosary should help you to experience deeper meditation, contemplation, and vision. The Salvation Rosary can help us to prepare for the "Missionary Life of the Church." You could use your fingers for the prayers so that it can be said anywhere you go.) Mysteries could be said: Joyful, Mon. & Sat.; Sorrowful, Tues. & Fri.; Light, Thur.; Glorious, Wed. & Sun. Faith Belief is (FB.) The Sorrowful Mysteries January 1, 2023

1st The Agony in the Garden

1. Jesus prayed: "Father, if possible, let this cup of suffering pass from me, but not my will, but your will be done." MT 26:39
2. Jesus was in such agony his sweat was like drops of blood falling to the ground. LK 22:44
3. Jesus finds his disciples sleeping and says: "You could not stay awake with me and pray for one hour." Do we remember to "keep holy the Sabbath Day?" LK 22:46
4. Again, Jesus finds the disciples sleeping and not praying, he tells them: "The Spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak." MT 26
5. The third time, Jesus says: "Still sleeping? Get up. See my betrayer is here." Messages for all of us to stay awake and pray, because our time of suffering may be nearer than think. God allows us to suffer, like Jesus, because he also has a greater plan for us. MK 14:42
6. Judas went up to Jesus and said: "Hail Rabbi" and he kissed him, which was also a sign he never believed that Jesus was Lord. MT 26:49
7. Jesus says: "I was teaching in the Temple, but you did not arrest me there", as he tries to explain His mission from God His Father. MT 26:55
8. They tried to arrest Jesus. Peter, in a moment of anger, with his sword, cuts off the high priest's slave's right ear. JN 18:
9. Jesus says: "Put Back your sword, for all who live by the sword, die by the sword." Only with God's wisdom will we know how and when to stand for holy justice and truth. MT 26:52
10. Jesus touched the slave's ear and healed it. After this, the Jewish guards arrest Jesus, tied his hands and took him to Jerusalem. LK: 22:51& JN18:12

2nd Scouring at the Pillar

1. Jesus is accused of blasphemy by the high priest the corrupt Jewish leaders because they were looking for an excuse to kill him. MT 26:65
2. The rooster crows twice and Peter remembers he has denied knowing Jesus three times; then he breaks down and cries. MT 26:69
3. Judas regrets his betrayal of Jesus, loses his mind because he forgets, God will always be there to love us, forgive us and give us meaning to life. MT 27:3
4. Pilate asked Jesus: "What have you done?" Jesus replied: "My Kingdom does not belong to this world.", then He remains in silence. JN 18:35 & MT 27:14
5. Pilate tells the Jews that he finds Jesus not guilty of any crime as he tries to follow Roman Rule of Law, with his form of separation of church & state. LK23:13
6. The corrupt Jewish leaders who control their people: wealth, politics & religion, tell Pilate Jesus should be crucified but he knows it's because of envy. Pilate still tries to compromise with these "stiff necked" Levite priests who were willing to kill others to maintain their passion, wealth, power & fame. MT 27:12-18
7. To please the Jews, Pilate has Jesus brutally scourged at the pillar with forty lashes, which was enough to kill some men. MK 15:15
8. Pilate offers to release Jesus, or a killer named Barabbas. The Jews choose Barabbas, as they continually yell out, "crucify Jesus". MT 27:21
9. The corrupt Jewish leaders, who have their own false gods, threaten Pilate when they said, if he releases Jesus, "he is no friend of Caesar's". JN 19:12
10. Now Pilate fears the bribes of these misguided Jewish leaders with Caesar, which could affect his political career, so he participates with the Jews to crucify Jesus. JN19:13(FB)

3rd The Crowning with Thorns

1. Pilate washes his hands with water and says "he is innocent of this man's blood" as he tries to hide the fact that he is a corrupt political judge. MT 27:24
2. The Jewish leaders say: "Let his blood be upon us and upon our children.", because they had no belief in heaven or hell, take what you can get here. MT27:25
3. Pilate writes an inscription in three languages to be put on the cross which said: "Jesus, King of the Jews," because he wanted the whole world to know, there was something very special about this man, as he also tries to clear his conscience. The Jewish leaders try to get Pilate to change his wording, but he refuses. MT 27:37
4. The soldiers say that Jesus is a King, but he has no crown, so, they hold a mock court & crowning for Jesus, so they could have some fun. JN19:2 & MT27:27
5. They weave a crown out of long, sharp thorns for Jesus, as he will become the first person in history to be crucified with a crown of thorns. MT 27:29
6. The soldiers pressed the crown of thorns deep into Jesus' scalp and he bled continuously until he was wrapped into the donated burial shroud. MK 15:17
7. They put a dirty royal purple cloak around him as if he were a King, and they spit on Jesus. Many of us do the same thing to Jesus each day. MK 15:17
8. They put a long hard reed in Jesus' right hand, as a sign of his power and authority, then they keep hitting him over the head with it. MT 27:29
9. The soldiers mocked Jesus and said: "Hail, King of the Jews." as they laughed and made fun of him. The world persecutes His church in much the same way each day. How often we support the devil, the prosecutor, to weaken the Christian faith. We are responsible for this. MT 27:29
10. Jesus taught, "go and learn the meaning of it is mercy that I desire, and not sacrifice". He leaves this question for all peoples of all times. MT 9:13

4th The Carrying of the Cross

1. The soldiers mount the old, rugged cross on Jesus' back, also a sign to us, we too will carry this old rugged cross until they day we die. JN 19:17 (FB)
2. Jesus carries the cross down the road that is known as "The Via Dolorosa", "The Way of the Cross of Suffering to Salvation". (FB) JN 19:17
3. The unfaithful Jewish leaders encourage the people to yell, "Blasphemer" as they spit on Jesus to show how powerful they were. (FB) MK 14:63
4. Jesus falls the first time, and the women mourn and lament for him because of his great persecution and injustice being done to Him. LK 23:17 (FB)
5. Jesus falls the second time, as he meets his mother, who can do nothing except pray, weep, and be present to him in his suffering. (FB)
6. Veronica, as a sign of mercy, takes her veil and wipes the face of Jesus which leaves a lasting impression of His face on her veil. (FB)
7. Jesus falls the third time from total exhaustion and another way of seeing He was also fully human and suffered as we do. LK 23:26
8. Simon of Cyrene is pressed into service to carry the cross for Jesus, also a sign that God always sends people to help us carry our crosses. LK 23:26
9. Jesus speaks to the women of Jerusalem about the coming destruction of their country Israel because people would not follow the Commandments to love God with all their heart and to love their neighbor as themselves. "This is the whole Torah and all the rest is commentary." (Hillel) LK 23:28 (FB)
10. A large crowd follows Jesus as he climbs the hill of Calvary because the people had faith and belief in Him that he was Lord and Messiah. LK 23:27

5th The Crucifixion

1. Jesus is stripped of his clothes and brutally nailed to the Cross by the soldiers; then they divide his garments among them by casting dice. JN19:23
2. Jesus prays: "Father forgive them for they know not what they do." As he also knows that without conversion to God's ways, they will experience "from the measure with which you measure, will be measured back to you." LK 23:34 + LK 6:38
3. He tells the repentant sinner on the cross next to him: "Today you will be with me in Paradise.", which is also to let us know that anyone can be saved, even at the last moments of their life. This man's heart was closed, but now open to God's love. LK 24:43
4. Jesus says to his mother Mary, "Woman, behold your son," and to John, the beloved disciple, "behold your mother", as he gives her care and protection to John because Jesus has no other brothers and sisters. There is no Greek word for cousins, like they have in the Hebrew, so family often called themselves: brothers and sisters. The Bible names many of his cousins as his brothers and sisters. JN 19:26 + ACTS 1:132
5. Jesus says: "I thirst", then he drinks the final wine to complete the Passover meal. Now He begins to pray Psalm 22. "My God, my God, why have you abandoned me..." and then He continues this memorized prayer of Faith and Trust in God, to the end. MK 16:34 + JN 19:28
6. Jesus prays: "It is finished", "Father, into your hands I commend my spirit" then He dies. Now he enters limbo, a waiting place for the dead. JN19:30 & LK23:46
7. After the earthquake, the Roman centurion said: "Truly this man was the Son of God", as he becomes converted to Jesus Christ. MK 15:39 (FB)
8. The curtain in the temple is torn in two from top to bottom & now all people have access to God's New Covenant, written on their hearts, "I will be your God and you will be my people." This also shows Jesus did not intend to reform Judaism, but to start a new religion for all people in the universe. MK 15:38 (FB)
9. A soldier thrust a lance into the Sacred Heart of Jesus and blood and water gushed out, also symbolizing a new life with the waters of baptism and His Blood for Divine Mercy and forgiveness of sins, for all people of this world, as seen in a vision by Saint Faustina in 1937 at the start of WW II. JN 19:34 (FB)
10. Joseph of Arimathea has Jesus' bleeding body taken down from the cross and laid into the arms of His Mother Mary, followed by being wrapped in the shroud, then buried in Joseph's own tomb. The Christ of Faith will now lead us to Good Works of building His Kingdom for all people on earth. JN19:38 (FB)
