Patrol Leaders' Council Meeting

Monday, August 19, 2024, 7:00 pm at Emmaus

A Patrol Leaders' Council (PLC) meeting is a key part of how a Scout troop operates and is a fundamental element of the Boy Scouts of America's "youth-led" approach.

The PLC is a gathering of the troop's youth leaders—primarily the Senior Patrol Leader (SPL), Assistant Senior Patrol Leaders (ASPLs), Patrol Leaders (PLs), and other key youth positions. The meeting is typically led by the SPL and focuses on planning and organizing troop activities. Adult leaders (like the Scoutmaster) usually attend but serve as advisors, allowing the youth leaders to make decisions.

The PLC is an essential way for Scouts to take on leadership roles and guide the direction of the troop, helping them develop decision-making, teamwork, and leadership skills.
