Ask your unit leaders, local schools, religious intuitions, parks, forest preserves, county, or city for project ideas. Ask your unit, benefactor, and local council about your specific ideas before you begin.

- The project will be a "...service project benefiting any religious institution, school, or community..."
 - The project can be for a church, parsonage, school, publis nursing home, city library, public humain society, state nature center, city/state park, forrest preserve, or city, state, federal government, etc.
 - The project cannot be done for the BSA, a private nursing home, a private sports complex, a private dog shelter, a commercial business, etc.
- "Routine labor, a job or service normally rendered, should not be considered."
 - This may exclude cleaning, repainting, refinish, cleaning out, re-arranging, mowing, weeding, remove grafitti, reoccuring blood, book, clothing, or food drives, adopt a highway or hydrant, volunteering, etc.
