Here are some items from the PLC:



Log in to Scoutbook and visit the troop calendar page by going to Dashboard -> Troop 52 -> Upcoming Events. Once there, under the calendar grid, click "subscribe" next to Troop 52 and follow the directions on your screen to paste it into your calendar. Trail to First Class Activities – Starting April 9, 2022 – 9:00-11:00 am

Troop 52 scouts,

Each month Mr. Schulenberg will be hosting Trail to First Class workshops at Lakeway City Park. Beginning on April 9, these workshops will take place on the second Saturday of every month from 9-11 AM at the upper pavilion. We will focus on rank advancement skills and knowledge from Scout through First Class. All scouts are welcome to join in, to listen, learn, and participate. For the older scouts, this is an opportunity to earn rank advancement by helping to lead these sessions by demonstration the EDGE method.

During these 2 hour sessions we will work together through each of the requirements in Scout, Tenderfoot, Second Class, and First Class, including some of the more challenging activities such as first aid, knots, fire building, nature hikes, and the physical fitness requirements. Our goal is to have fun and learn from each other.

Sea Base - Spring Break 2023 - March 10-18, 2023

Good news! We were able to secure a spot for Sea Exploring on a tall ship for Sea Base in March 10-18, 2023. **Registration is now open in the store section of the troop web site.** The first payment of \$150 per person secures your spot. Spots will fill up fast, so please register quickly. The minimum age for this trip is 13 years old. This will require extra travel expenses for flights to and from Miami.



If your scout is attending summer camp this June and wants to participate in Whitewater Rafting then please head over to the Troop 52 store to sign up! The cost would be an additional \$100 per attendee with everything included (wetsuit, booties, life jacket, etc.).

The deadline for paying for Whitewater Rafting will be April 10th. After that we will be finalizing the roster and won't be able to add any more rafters. Adults and scouts who attend would be the same \$100 amount to raft. Proof of passing the scout swimming qualification must be completed prior to rafting.



Sign up for Summer Camp 2022 – San Isabel Scout Ranch – Beulah, Colorado (June 18th - 26th)

Summer camp 2022 is at San Isabel Scout Ranch in the heart of the San Isabel National Forest just outside of Pueblo, Colorado.

Second payment of \$250 is due by March 1st.

It's not too late to sign up - If you are interested in going, please pay \$500 per person by March 1st (comprises of 1st and 2nd installments).

Final payment of \$150 (scouts) or \$70 (adults) is due by April 1st.

We are also planning on White Water rafting – if you are interested that will cost an additional \$100 per person.

We applied for - and received - 2 treks for Philmont in June of 2023. We will be leaving Austin on 6/24/23 and returning on 7/8/23.

We have room for 16 Scouts and 8 Adults to join in this adventure (many of these slots have been spoken for) so please sign up via Scout Book and secure your spot with a deposit by January 15, 2022.

Scouts will need to be 14 years old by 6/25/23 (or have completed 8th grade).

The 12-Day Reservation fee is \$1,500.00/person with payment schedule as follows:

- Advance of \$670.00/person due 9/1/2022
- Balance of \$670.00/person due 2/1/2023
