PLC – May 9, 2022 – 7:00 pm – Emmaus

We are having PLC on Monday, May 9, at 7:00 pm at Emmaus. Please come prepared to discuss our troop events for the summer and fall. We will discuss the months June through November to get a tentative calendar in place for summer activities, Court of Honor, and fall campouts that will need reservations.



Committee Meeting – May 10, 2022 – 7:00 pm – Location TBD (open to suggestions)

Please join the troop adults for the Troop Committee Meeting. This meeting will be an important one to finalize summer and fall plans. The next one will probably not be scheduled until July due to summer camp. All interested adults should attend. The PLC is for the boys to make plans. The Committee meeting is for the adults to find a way to implement what the boys voted for at the PLC. Scouts should not attend. All adults are welcome to be a part of the troop committee to discuss troop operations and make plans for the remainder of the year. If you would like a say in how the troop is run, then this is the meeting for you. We have several committee positions where we could use your help.



Swim Test – Nitro Swimming – 11:30 am, May 14, 2022

Each year, scouts must recertify at the BSA swim test. It is a requirement for all aquatic activities, including summer camp, the canoeing campout, kayaking activities on Lake Travis, Sea Base, and any other activities involving swimming or water. Completing the swim test is also Requirement 6A for earning First Class. This year, we are pleased once again to do our swim test at Nitro in Bee Cave, located at 15506 West Hwy 71 #D, Bee Cave, TX 78738. The test moves quickly, so don't be late. We use multiple lanes at the pool. Both scouts and adults must take the swim test. We ask for a \$5 cash donation to give to the Nitro employees as a tip.

The requirements are: Jump feetfirst into water over the head in depth. Level off and swim 75 yards in a strong manner using one or more of the following strokes: sidestroke, breaststroke, trudgen, or crawl; then swim 25 yards using an easy resting backstroke. The 100 yards must be completed in one swim without stops and must include at least one sharp turn. After completing the swim, rest by floating. Scouts who complete this are classified as swimmers. Scouts who can swim only 25 yards are classified as beginners. Anyone who does not take the swim test is labeled a non-swimmer.

We have begun collecting your forms. If they are complete, please turn them in to Mr. Konda. Camp will deny entry if your forms are incomplete or incorrect, so please don't delay.



Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (IOLS) Training – June 4-5 Attention Troop 52 Adults,

Good news! We have been granted permission by Bee Cave District leadership to conduct our own Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (IOLS) training course instead of sending our people to something like Mega Training or other council level events. This course will certify you to be a trained Assistant Scoutmaster (ASM). We need your attendance. Instructors will be existing Troop 52 adults who have already taken IOLS.

IOLS covers almost all the rank requirements for scouts up to First Class. Adults will learn the patrol method and the necessary skills to be an ASM to teach the scouts. Since IOLS requires an overnight stay, we have been given permission to camp at the Nature Conservancy on Saturday night, June 4, then departing Sunday before noon. This will be an all-day course. There will be no partial credit or leaving early.

There will be more details forthcoming along with a supply sheet, but I wanted to go ahead and get this on the calendar. Please RSVP to me. This will be a great opportunity for you to achieve ASM status prior to summer camp. Your service to the boys is much appreciated. Our troop can only be as strong as the commitment of our adults to serve the boys, so thank you for your help.

NOTE: This is for adults only. No scouts. It is contingent on having enough adults to participate in order to learn to function as a couple of patrols.
