## **Motorboating Merit Badge is being offered**

Summer is upon us, and that means it is time for our annual Motorboating Merit Badge Workshop!

Workshop Requirements:

- You must attend part 1 (Wednesday, July 10th from 6:30-9:00 PM taught at our home) before attending part 2 (Monday, July 15th from 8 AM-2 PM taught on a boat on Lake Travis/The Reserve at Lake Travis Marina). You must attend both sessions and complete all of the requirements to earn this Merit Badge.
- This workshop is for Scouts who are First Class rank and above.
- You must pass the swim test before attending.

There are 4 spots available for this workshop. If there are more than 4 Scouts wanting to participate, we will likely open up another session.

We will also need 1 adult volunteer to help us on the boat on July 15th.

This class is taught by Randy and Josi Bogdon.
