We will have new positions set before the beginning of July with the term expiring December 31, 2024.

Calling All Parents!

Any parent who is not a registered scoutmaster or assistant scoutmaster is needed to serve on Boards of Review!

All Parents, you each have a scout needing to advance and we need parents to help with the process to help each scout, including yours, to advance with each rank.

What is a Board of Review?

The purpose of a board of review is to determine the quality of a Scout's experience through a conversation between the Scout and 3-6 members of the troop committee. It should be viewed as a chance to talk with the Scout about what they've done, what they've learned and how they're enjoying the program. It's required for every rank in Scouts BSA from Tenderfoot to Eagle Scout and should happen after the Scoutmaster conference.

"The board of review is not a retest of any sort," "It's supposed to be more of a check-in time, **asking them how things are going.**"

The whole thing should take 15-30 minutes. At the end, the Scout leaves the room while the board deliberates. If the board agrees unanimously that the Scout is ready to advance, the Scout is called back in and congratulated.
