Cruise Guest Tips

Prepare for Rain

Bergen is beautiful in all weather, but rain is very common. Waterproof jackets and comfortable shoes are essential.

Stay Overnight if Possible

Many cruise guests only see Bergen briefly, but the city becomes even more magical in the evenings after ships depart.

Dress in Layers

Weather can change rapidly, especially during fjord excursions.

Best Photography Times

Early morning and late evening offer the best lighting around Bryggen and the harbor.
