





act, fiction, and fantastic scenery abound on this vibrant vacation and historical journey through New England and the Hudson Valley.

This undiscovered tour appropriately kicks off in Boston and nearby Lexington, the "Birthplace of American Liberty," where the opening shots of the Battles of Lexington and Concord were fired in 1775. Digest the fascinating history of the American Revolution before a hearty New England lunch at the historic Concord Colonial Inn which was once used as an arms and provision storehouse for the local Patriots.

Leaving Concord's Old North Bridge, site of "the shot heard round the world," you can hear a pin drop as you visit the storied city of Salem and head toward the peaceful vistas of coastal Maine, rural New Hampshire, and mountainous Vermont. Charming seaport villages, bucolic covered bridges, and rolling maple syrup farms sweeten the storylines across America's historic East Coast. Swirl and sip at Vermont's sustainable Shelburne Vineyard, enjoy a lighthouse-keeper presentation in Portland, Maine, and learn why everyone's eyes light up upon tasting Freeport's famous Whoopie Pie.

The plot thickens as you ferry across Lake Champlain to immerse yourself in the scene stealers of New York and Massachusetts, including the resort village and Olympic Games site of Lake Placid, the picturesque Berkshire Mountains, and the orchard- and vineyard dotted riverbanks of the quaint Hudson Valley. You'll have time to explore the legendary sights of timeless Tarrytown, the setting of Washington Irving's *The Legend of Sleepy Hollow*, and tour the waterfront U.S. Military Academy at West Point where you'll want to be sure to stand up straight. You wouldn't want to miss the spectacular views.

Make your way from bucolic horse country and the Great Smoky Mountains to the South's current "it" cities of Asheville, Nashville, and Chattanooga. You'll first take the reins in the land of mares, mint juleps, and mandolins with a special evening of bluegrass entertainment as well as visits to a centuries-old bourbon distillery, a Lexington thoroughbred horse farm, and Louisville's legendary Brown Hotel to taste its famous Hot Brown open-faced sandwich.

The drool-worthy sights continue as you cruise along the South's most scenic highways to the majestic peaks and even more imposing mansions the region is known for. In the shadow of the Blue Ridge Mountains, George Vanderbilt's grand Biltmore Estate welcomes you for a guided tour of the 250-room home—the largest privately owned home in the U.S.—and a farm-to-table lunch in its boutique- and bistro-lined Antler Hill Village. Make sure you save room for a night on the town in eclectic Asheville, known for its low key vibe and high number of microbreweries.

There's plenty to toast in two more of the South's emerging cities where the music, dining, and art scenes have the world taking notice. In the charismatic, waterfront city of Chattanooga, you'll visit the pop culture-themed Songbird Guitar Museum and taste the city's famous MoonPie treat before heading to Nashville for guided sightseeing, a farewell dinner, and accommodations near the melodious sounds of Honky Tonk Row.



eauty, awe, and wonder echo from Phoenix to Vegas as you explore ancient cliff dwellings, towering spires, the deepest of canyons, and the deepest of mysteries. Exactly how *did* the Sinagua people reach their cliffside, five-story, high rise at Montezuma Castle?

Explore these enigmas and more as you visit the lost canyons and cultures of the American Southwest. Hop in a 4-wheel-drive backcountry vehicle with a local Navajo guide and cruise through 5,000 years of uninterrupted civilization at Canyon de Chelly National Monument—home to ancient ruins, spires, and petroglyphs as well as modern-day Navajo families. You'll also feel the wind in your hair on a guided Jeep tour through the stunning red rock scenery and sandstone formations of striking Sedona, and on the Verde Canyon Scenic Railroad should you choose to take in the breathtaking, high-desert scenery from an outdoor viewing car.

Other sights in canyon country that will make a lasting impact are Meteor Natural Landmark, the world's best preserved meteorite impact site on earth; Taliesin West, Frank Lloyd Wright's beloved winter home; the Hubbell Trading post, the oldest, continuously operating trading post in the American Southwest; and the majestic Grand Canyon where you'll enjoy a scenic train ride from Williams, Arizona to the Canyon's South Rim. Want to marvel at millions of years of geological history from a different perspective? How about an optional helicopter ride?

This lost canyon tour also includes a tour of the Desert Botanical Garden in Phoenix to admire its thousands of species of cacti and flowers, a visit to the Hoover Dam—a marvel of engineering built during the Great Depression, and just enough time in "Sin City" to avoid any deep trouble. 

Just as the Klondike stampeders traversed snow-covered mountains, crossed raging whitewater rapids, and quenched their thirst in rowdy saloons, you can too. The only difference is you don't have to rush. On this leisurely vacation through Alaska and the Yukon, you can take your time relishing each golden moment.

While the gold seekers scaled this rugged terrain on foot, you'll comfortably watch for whales and dolphins aboard a glacier cruise through Prince William Sound; see the sights of Fairbanks and the Chena River from an authentic sternwheeler riverboat; admire North America's highest peak aboard the Alaska Railroad to Denali National Park & Preserve; and take in the panoramic views on a thrilling ride along the Top of the World Highway that connects Alaska to the Yukon. An optional train ride on the narrow-gauge White Pass & Yukon Railway, a marvel of engineering, promises wide-open views of peaks, waterfalls, glaciers, and gorges as you sit back in a vintage passenger car.

In a land of extremes, you'll also visit Whitehorse, the territorial headquarters of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, before a trip back in time to the lawless era of 1898 when gold seekers hit the trails in search of their fortunes. Dip your fingers into Bonanza Creek, site of Claim #1 in Dawson City, and try your hand at poker at Diamond Tooth Gertie's Saloon where you'll enjoy a traditional miner's evening of ragtime, rye, and roulette.

Additional nuggets of fun on this tour of Alaska include a tour of a Chena Indian Village, a visit to Iditarod Headquarters—home of the great dogsled race, and an overnight in Valdez, the "Switzerland of Alaska."



A Ithough the Pacific Northwest might be known for its light rain showers, the locals know that it's the freshly brewed coffee, perfectly crafted beer, and robust local wines that really pour. Clear your schedule and your palate for this tasty undiscovered tour through the natural wonders, lush wilderness, and picturesque wineries of scenic Washington and Oregon.

Drink in the alpine architecture and German beer in the Bavarian village of Leavenworth in the Cascade Mountains; wake up in the coastal city of Astoria to its charming, Victorian-era hillside homes; savor the malt and hops at any number of Bend's two dozen breweries; and take a break in the dairy den of Tillamook for a taste of its world famous cheese and ice cream.

Along the breathtaking Three Capes Scenic Loop, you also won't want to miss the inactive but charming Cape Meares Lighthouse, Oregon's shortest lighthouse standing only 38 feet tall. While the coast's other fabled lighthouses cast their beams to reveal the wonders of the Pacific Northwest, your native Tour Director will shed light on what makes this corner of the country so uniquely spectacular—from the robust Cabernets of the Yakima Valley to the meaty shellfish fresh from the waters of Newport, the "Dungeness Crab Capital of the World."

If the Seattle coffee scene doesn't wake you up—or the fragrant aroma of 10,000 rose bushes at Portland's International Rose Test Garden at Washington Park—a dune buggy ride along the Oregon coast, Mt. Hood's 611-foot-tall Multnomah Falls, and the sheer magnitude of Crater Lake National Park certainly will. Get ready for an endless array of eye-opening experiences.



Almost heaven, West Virginia, Blue Ridge Mountains, Shenandoah River.
