

2024 MCC KARTPLEX Summer Rental Kart Rumble League

The 2024 Summer Rental League at MCC Kartplex will be a 6 round championship featuring a different layout each round. Registration fee is \$600 for all 6 rounds (100\$ per round) Paying \$600 guarantees spot for all 6 rounds guarantees your spot. A second registration will open if the classes do not fill up and a driver can register for each round. Each class is capped at 14 drivers. Two run groups of light and medium will be run to make it fair and equal. Online registration is available, each class will be capped at 14 entries; spots are first come first serve. A waitlist will be available if all spots are filled. Drivers must come run a rental kart session at least once prior to May 19th, 2024 and obtain MCC Rental Rumble License to be eligible to run in the league.

(Race Director reserves right to change track layout)

(No Drops, all drivers must have license to race in league.)

Drivers can practice prior to the event. No rental practice day of event. Track layout practice will be available day before event as well as other days that will be scheduled.

Class Structure

Light Division 560 lbs. (driver 120-160 lbs.) Medium Division 600 lbs. (driver 200 lbs. +)

Drivers must meet minimum weight for division. The minimum weight for driver to be eligible is 120 pounds. If driver is between 160-200 lbs., Driver can add weight for medium or be overweight for light. Driver weighs in prior to hitting the track, total combined kart and driver to be scaled after heat and final. Weight is available if necessary, kart is capable of 40lbs addition

Rules and Regulations:

- Drivers must be 14 years of age or older and 55' height requirement to reach pedals.
- Drivers must register for Rental Kart Rumble for their respective class via Alpha Timing.
- Drivers must obtain MCC Rental Kart Rumble License (Before May 19th, 2024) to be eligible to race in the league.
- To obtain MCC Rental Kart License, a time of 1:22.0 or faster must be ran to be able to get a license.
- Driver must weigh no less than 120 lbs. to be eligible. Weight will be provided to rent if a
 driver cannot make class weight.
- Drivers can register prior to the start of the season. It is drivers responsibility to have MCC Rental Kart License prior to May 19th to be eligible. If your license isn't obtained by May 19th, 2024, and a driver is registered, you will be dropped from the league.
- A waitlist will be available if all 14 spots in each class cap out.
- The driver's meeting is mandatory and will start at 6:00pm. All drivers must attend.
- Drivers must meet the weight in their class to run. Weight will be provided and added to the
 driver's kart. Weight will cost \$2 per pound to rent for the entire season. No weight is
 allowed on any driver's person. (Driver must meet minimum weight requirements)
- Drivers will be in a different kart all three sessions.
- Qualifying starting order will be positioned by championship points.
- Prefinal and Final will be a double file rolling start. The Pace car will guide the field around
 the course. Lights out on the pace car indicate the race will be going green. The pole sitter
 will control the field when the pace car pulls in and must keep the pace slow until the green
 flag. Drivers must line up in the tram lanes and must stay within them until the green flag.
 Once the green flag is out you may accelerate and can make passes. No passing is
 allowed prior to the green flag, penalties will be enforced. Jump starts will be a 5 second
 time penalty.
- In the event of a local or full course yellow drivers must hold position. Position penalties will be enforced if passing under yellow occurs.
- In the event of a full course yellow, the pace car will be released and will go out in front of
 the leader. The pace car will stay out until the track is clear to go back to racing. When the
 lights go out on the pace car it will indicate the race will be going back green and will be
 restarted. All race restarts will be single file. The leader must maintain a slow pace coming
 to the green flag and all karts must stay single file until the green flag.
- In the event of a red flag, all drivers must come to a slow complete stop. Once the track is ready to resume racing the track will go full course yellow followed by a race restart.
- All drivers must pay attention to penalty boards at start/finish and 16 corner lights.
- Rough driving will not be tolerated and may result in disqualification from the event. Rough
 driving will be assessed by the race director. If you move a kart out of the way to gain a
 position you must give the position back or receive a position penalty.
- Blocking is allowed but only one move can be made to the kart behind you. You cannot
 move in reaction to the kart behind you. You cannot make a second move after the first.
 Blocking will be looked at by the race director and race officials, penalties can be assessed.
- Bad behavior and/or foul language will not be tolerated.
- The championship winner will receive a test day with Trinity Karting Group. The top 2 in each class will be rewarded with a free team entry into Dan Beard Memorial Endurance Race. (September 21st)
