→ **A Catalog of Protocols for the Internet of Things**

Postscapes has published a [catalog of protocols](#) used in IoT devices and applications, aiming to provide clarification "with IoT layer technology stack and head-to-head comparisons." The 75 protocols listed are classified -- and occasionally misclassified -- into the following categories:

- Infrastructure
- Identification
- Communications and Transport
- Discovery
- Data protocols
- Device Management
- Semantic
- Multi-layer Frameworks

The document also presents several architecture frameworks or protocol stacks, copied from other resources (with attribution). The description of each protocol is skimpy, but has a link to the original source. Don't expect this to add insights, but as a glossary and catalog, it is a useful resource.
