

2021/2022 School Year Program Policies

Little Red Schoolhouse is an in-person Preschool Pod for Children ages 3-5 years of age. The objective of the program during the 2021/2022 school year is to provide a high quality preschool experience to a small group of preschoolers who's families have concerns about Covid-19 exposure, but still want their child to attend preschool. We are offering a strong, preschool program for parents wanting to keep their child on track socially, emotionally, cognitively and physically.

Our teaching methods are hands-on. We use age appropriate materials to give children a very strong foundation academically.

All preschoolers are required to bring a mask to school each day. Grownups are required to wear masks in the classroom.

Potty Training: Being Potty Trained is not a requirement. Students who are not potty trained will be encouraged to use the potty during potty breaks with no pressure during the first semester. If the child has not been potty trained by the end of the first semester we will discuss a potty training plan with parents during our mid-year Parent/Teacher Conference that will work best for that child. We will begin actively potty training together 2nd semester.

Uniform: Little Red Schoolhouse T-shirt or Polo (included in enrollment) with comfortable bottoms

Meals: Meals will not be provided. You will have to bring a lunch for your child.

Fees:

\$70/Week/Child \$50/Week/ Siblings

\$70 Registration Fee. This is a one-time, non-refundable fee to cover the cost of materials.

\$70 payments are due weekly via our auto-pay system. If you do not wish to enroll in auto-pay you can choose to pay for each semester in full. The weekly fee will be the same regardless of if your child misses a school day or not to hold your child's spot and cover operational fees. We have a generous make-up policy for missed lessons/classes. Please see Covid precautions below for information on makeup days.

Withdrawal:

Please give a 2 week notice of your intent to withdraw.

Parent Communication:

- *Daily communication, pictures and reminders will be sent to parents via the Brightwheel app.
- *All children must be signed in each morning using the Brightwheel app.
- *If you are dropping off a new medication for your child you will need to speak to the teacher that morning about the purpose of the medication, dosages, doctor's notes etc.
- *Teachers will be available 15 minutes after the end of school each day to communicate face to face as well.

Covid-Precautions and Safety:

- *Teachers will arrive early to sanitize the classroom
- *No outside people will be permitted to enter the classroom during preschool time.
- * Teachers are vaccinated and will continue to social distance and wear masks in public in order to keep our preschoolers safe.
- *Lakehouse doors will be open during preschool pickup and drop off time. Doors will be locked during preschool time.
- *Temperature Checks required at the door.
- *Any child displaying any signs of sickness will not be permitted to return in-person until 7 days after symptoms have stopped.(Unless condition is excused by doctor's note)
- *Generous Make-up policy. Make up lessons offered on Tuesdays via Zoom. Parents may pick up packets of missed work from the Lakehouse office. Signs of sickness: fever, coughing, vomiting, diarrhea
- *Families who have been notified that they have been in contact with a Covid positive person must notify teacher and follow sick child policy above. They are welcome to makeup missed lessons on Tuesday and pick up makeup work from the Lakehouse office

Enrollment:

We are accepting enrollments for the 2020/2021 School Year. Applications can be submitted on our program's website. By submitting your application you agree that you have read and agree to our program's policies.

To enroll submit your application for approval. Once your application is approved we will email a link to enroll in our auto-pay system. There are limited spaces available for our program.
