The commitment by Strategic UK Group is to support young people to uncover their potential and their ideas for starting up their business. Regardless of the barriers young people who are unemployed or under-employed Strategic UK Group encourage young people to come forward with their ideas and concept of a product

and services to starting their own business.

There is inconsiderable untapped potential in disadvantaged young people and their ideas. Research shows the extent to which young people from disadvantaged backgrounds, who are unemployed or under-employed, are interested in developing ideas into products and services, and starting their own business.

- Two in five of these young people 39% have had ideas for products and services they think they could sell and more than half 54% would like to run their own business.
- More than one third 36% of these young people have previously earned money selling something online.

Assurance to young people is to reinforce their entrepreneurial journey. With the New Business Start-up Programme is to encourage young people to come forward and engage with the programme to explain their ideas and concept of a product or service young people would like to create or explore.

Our **Commitment to Young People** is to support their business start-up journey through our focused objectives.

1. Supporting young people to starting up their own business requires understanding the type of business young people looking to start-up. The programme needs to engage young people of different personality types identified through research e.g., open-minded, knowledgeable, reliable, passionate, unconfident, flexible, bored, motivated, risk taker, entrepreneurial, none of these. Engagement with these personality types to understand the type of start-up business a young person is interested in setting up.
