During the last week of July I had the joy of being a coadvisor for Young Adult Advisory Delegates. My role was to support and cheer on young adults who spoke up, advised commissioners how to vote, and to generally answer questions.

I didn't get to see as much of the meeting as I hoped to, but was caught up pretty quickly. At the end of each day, sometimes multiple times a day, we heard a moderator say, "Can we ask Ian Hall about the financial implications of our decisions?" Ian Hall, (PCUSA CFO) would come up onstage, sometimes with a bar graph, and often the per capita changes, and explain what each decision made at General Assembly did to the budget, which would need to be approved by the end of the week. Somehow, Ian Hall became a bit of a celebrity in the PCUSA circles, but that is a story for another time.

As fiscally responsible Presbyterians, and stewards of the resources God gives us, we should and do consider financial implications of our choices and actions. We don't ask for a bar graph as often as General Assembly commissioners do, but I think it's fair to say money is often on our minds.

Financial Implications are important. I say this as we begin talking about our Stewardship campaign. But there are other implications to our actions - human imOlications, environmental, communal. What might be the most fiscally responsible might not be the most environmentally or ethically responsible.

As we enter a time of pondering how we might best give of our gifts, let's look not just at financial gifts, but the gifts God has given us.
