Christmas and Advent are times in which theologians love to pull out the big, theological sounding words. We remember that Jesus is also called "Emmanuel," which means "God-with-us." Mary is called the "Theotokos" in Greek. This is a word that means "God-bearer." Advent is a Latin word that means "to come." We spend the season before Christmas waiting for not only Jesus' birth, but also his return to create a world that is whole.

You might have seen the signs that say, "Keep Christ in Christmas!" These always make me chuckle just a little bit because my college Greek comes back to me every time. Sometimes this is a political statement about the busyness and consumerism of Christmas, but sometimes it is also a response to seeing "Merry X-mas!" The Greek scholar in me finds this interesting because the Greek word for Christ is Christos - and Greek, like Hebrew, uses a different alphabet, so the first letter in the word "Christos" actually looks like an X.

So, why is it important to tell you about these words? For one, I love these words. "God-with-us" and "God-bearer" are powerful images of the ways in which God goes with us, and also that we bear the image of God in the world.

Secondly, I think it is important to remember that the story of this infant began in a different land, in a different time, and a different language was spoken. To me, it causes a sacred pause that reminds us that there is much we don't know, much we have yet to learn, and that God speaks to us across time, place, and language. Selah.
