1. Download a nomination form from the CSRN group on LinkedIn.


Each team can enter themselves for one award only and yes, you can nominate your own team!

Entry information:

- Entries must be submitted no later than Friday 14th August 2020.
- Projects must have occurred between June 2020 and August 2020 and have been conducted as part of the CSR programme. Other achievements cannot be included.
- It is strongly recommended that you keep your entry **concise** and to the point whilst always backed up by **metrics/results/data**.
- Additional visuals may be included to enhance your entry but please note that these documents may only be reviewed if **necessary** at the panel's discretion. You must include any supplementary information as appendices **within this Word document**. Other attachments will not be accepted.
- Once you have completed the form please send it to csrawardsubmissions@accenture.com. Entering by any other means will invalidate your submission.

Section 1: Insight

1. Peer Voting Period

The judges will select a winning team for each category who they will be announced live in our online awards event – date TBC!
