# FOUNDATION

Foundation Program is equivalent to upper secondary school (Year 12). It aims to prepare students for further study in a Navitas College's International Year 1 or for entry into the first year of a selected University bachelor degree.

Various support services focusing on a range of modules relevant to your chosen degree, language, literacy and numeracy assistance are also available

Assessment for all units is continuous and includes tests, assignments and case study analysis.

# DIPLOMA

Students will complete the first year of the degree, undertaking the same modules as students entering the University directly.

Alongside the university modules, students entering through the First Year Pathway will have additional support and tuition from Navitas College.

Students who successfully complete these courses will enter the second year of a Bachelor at the University.

# PRE MASTER'S

The Pre-Master's has been designed to prepare students who have not qualified for direct entry to Master's degrees.

Undertaking a Pre-Master's course will develop– academic communication, intercultural capability, research methodology and project management skills and prepare students to get the most out of the postgraduate study.

Assessment for most modules is continuous, and includes tests, assignments and a dissertation/project.

# Minimum Entry Requirements

- IB: Completion of Year 1 Diploma with at least 18 points (minimum of 4 subjects)
- Thai: M.5 with GPA 2.5
- Philippines: Year 11 (Academic Track) with overall average of 75%, OR Year 11 (Arts & Design/Sports Track) with overall average of 80%, OR Year 12 Senior High School Diploma (Technical-Vocational Livelihood Track) with overall average of 80%
- Myanmar: Matriculation with 55%

### Diploma:

- GCE: Minimum of 2 points from 2 GCE A-Levels subjects (2 AS-Level subjects may be used for 2nd subject)
- IB: 20 points from 6 IB subjects (one sitting)
- Thai: M.6 with GPA 2.0
- Philippines: Year 12 (Academic Track) with overall average of 80%
- Myanmar: Certificate IV. All other qualifications are assessed on a case-by-case basis

### Pre-Master's:

- Thai: Completion of a Bachelor degree with a GPA of 1.75 or better
- Philippines: Completion of any Bachelor degree in a non-professional discipline
- Myanmar: Completion of 3-year post-secondary (post Year 12 equivalent) qualification OR hold a Bachelor degree (or equivalent) from a recognized University which is comparable to an AQF Associate Degree

# Scholarship

## Diploma Pathway Scholarship

This scholarship is for all new International students. It will extend to your first year at Curtin University, if you achieve an academic level higher than Curtin University's standard entry requirements.

Please read through the Terms and Conditions below to confirm your eligibility.

## Scholarship Terms and Conditions

- This Scholarship is only for international, full fee-paying, non-sponsored students.
- This Scholarship is only for new commencing students at Curtin College.
- This Scholarship is available to students who are packaged with Curtin University and commences in the 2nd year of their Bachelor Degree no later than Semester 2, 2023.
- The Scholarship amount cannot be withdrawn by the student.
- This Scholarship covers a maximum of 12.5% of your Diploma tuition fees to a maximum of 200 credit points at Curtin College.
- If you achieve a course weight average of 65% in your Diploma course at the College, this Scholarship will be extended to cover a maximum of 12% of your first year tuition fee for your studies at Curtin University up to a maximum of 200 credit points only.

## Curtin English Language Program Subsidy

In collaboration with Curtin University, Curtin College offers an English Language Program Subsidy worth up to AUD\$6,580 towards Curtin English courses.

### Conditions of this subsidy offer:

- You must be an international, full fee-paying, student who has received a conditional offer to study at Curtin.
- Subsidy is not available to Australian citizens or Permanent Residents.
- You must not have met Curtin's English language requirements for entry into your Mainstream Course and must commence your Mainstream Course at Curtin's Perth campus within one year of the start date specified in your Letter of Offer.
- You must be undertaking an English Language Program to meet your English Requirement.
- You must be studying a full-time undergraduate degree, postgraduate degree by coursework or Higher Degree by Research program of at least 1 year and for a minimum of 200 credit points.
- You must pay upfront the fees associated with all your English Language Programs PLUS a A\$1,000 deposit (the **Deposit**) at the time you accept the packaged offer contained in your Letter of Offer (*different requirements apply to Sponsored students – see further below*)
- Curtin will credit the Deposit towards your tuition fee account in the second semester of your Mainstream course. If you do not continue to the Mainstream Course (whether you chose to withdraw or due to not meeting the English Requirement), the Deposit will be **non-refundable**.
- You must progress to your Mainstream Course and maintain your enrolment as an international, full fee-paying, student for at least one semester of your Mainstream Course. If you do not, then the Subsidy will be cancelled and you will not receive the Subsidy either in the form of a credit or refund of the tuition fees for your English Language Program (unless you qualify for any exceptions under the [Curtin English Refund Policy](#)).
- If your English Language Program costs less than the Subsidy, you cannot apply the Subsidy to any other international student expense or claim any remaining portion of the Subsidy. The Subsidy will only be applied to tuition, and enrolment fees.

# ADELAIDE SOUTH AUSTRALIA



Adelaide is South Australia's cosmopolitan coastal capital. The city's Adelaide Festival is an annual international arts gathering with spin-offs including fringe and film events.
