Barriers Encountered	We encountered some scheduling conflicts with child care providers having personal commitments, and a few no-shows. However, we still had enough participants to conduct the trainings. To avoid weather-related issues and low attendance, we typically refrain from planning in-person trainings in January and February. Instead, there are plenty of virtual training options during those months.							
Success Stories	A participant at the Regents Center's "How Can I Make That Sound" training commented that" it was one of the best trainings they've attended in 14 years." We scheduled this session on a Saturday to better accommodate providers' schedules. The training included a hands-on component where participants engaged with materials and learned how to use them with the children in their care. It focused specifically on infant and toddler care, supporting both home and center staff who work with this age group. Since infant/toddler trainings are harder to come by, we're making an effort to offer these options each year.							
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
