Barriers Encountered	<p>Due to COVID 19 we were still unable to offer many trainings face to face. This poses difficulty for any child care provider who does not have computer skills because Virtual Training wouldn't be an option for them either. Luckily relatives &amp; friends of providers have been able to lend a hand for those needing it. Also, looking ahead to next quarter there are more face to face trainings offered &amp; the Black Hawk Training Specialist assisted providers with getting enrolled and approved for those upcoming trainings.</p>							
Success Stories	<p>This quarter, providers were given approximately 15 choices of virtual &amp; face to face trainings through CCR&amp;R Region 2 / CCR&amp;R Statewide Webinars. Many options for receiving training hours were available despite the need to limit face to face trainings.</p> <p>Also, I-Power has limitless trainings virtually to choose from.</p> <p>We offered PITC Module 1 face to face at EPI Deery Center in September. Social distancing practices were followed as well as the mask mandate. Disinfecting prior to and after training occurred. We had a total of 10 child care providers complete 10 hours PITC Module 1 Training and another 3 attend but not finish every module for a total of 13 attended. Great turn out &amp; providers loved being back at a face to face training again!</p> <p>1 CCR&amp;R staff is a Nationally Certified Child Passenger Safety Technician, and is a part of the Cedar Valley Safe Riders group. Because of social distancing guidelines, technicians are providing one on one fittings with caregivers on a case by case basis. Techs are also available via email, phone, and there is a video to send the parent and walk them through installation process.</p>
