<p>Barriers Encountered</p>	<p>I have been working on reaching out to more prenatal moms who are referred for our baby safety program about other resources in the community. When I offer resources, many share they may be interested but want to wait until baby is born. I have continued to see an increase in out of county families delivering in the Cedar Valley. I do have a few resources available for families living in other counties if they are interested.</p>			
<p>Success Stories</p>	<p>I spoke with a mom who had just moved to the area a few weeks prior. While offering resources and explaining the different supports available in the community, she shared she was so thankful I had come in her room because she had no support here and was really interested in meeting new people. I was able to get her hooked up with parenting groups and other services to help her feel less isolated.</p>			

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
