



While Texas is amid an unprecedented active invasion of our sovereign southern border, numerous Texas Republican Congressional Representatives disregarded the warning from the House Freedom Caucus, which urged GOP Representatives to protect our military from medical tyranny and secure the southern border. Immigration issues do NOT belong in the National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA), and our military MUST be protected from forced medical tyranny.

Yet, the following TX GOP Congressional Representatives instead voted for two amendments further incentivizing illegal immigration:

Amendment by Rep. Deborah K Ross (D-NC) grants amnesty to 200,000 “documented dreamers”

Amendment by Rep Zoe Lofgren (D-CA) removed numerical caps allowing foreign tech workers with HB1 Visa permanent residency, further denying Texans and Americas from high-paying careers.
