- 450,000 coalition members recruited to stand up for America First values.

Strategic Wins and Key Victories:

In Nevada, our work helped elect Lydia Dominguez in District B and supported the campaigns of Sam Brown and Donald J. Trump. In Arizona, we were instrumental in securing victories for Julie Willoughby and Jeff Weninger in LD13, alongside other America First candidates like Lisa Fink, Tony Rivero, Steve Montenegro, and James Taylor.

Our reach extended across the nation, including Ohio, where our canvassing efforts contributed to Bernie Moreno's Senate victory, and widespread voter engagement in Pennsylvania, Michigan, North Carolina, Georgia, and beyond. **Our "Original Latinos for Trump" team in Miami-Dade flipped the county red** for Donald J. Trump, a monumental shift and testament to our influence.

In Texas's Rio Grande Valley, Latinos for America First has dedicated eight years to serving the community, supporting Border Patrol agents, and flipping counties like Hidalgo, Starr, Zapata, and Cameron for Trump. This election was the culmination of years of groundwork, community service, and an unshakeable commitment to conservative values.
