A Reflective Journaling Prompt for Educators

## 1. Reflection: What Does Success Look Like?

## 2. Compliance vs. Engagement

- In a recent lesson, where did I manage compliance?
- Where did students demonstrate genuine engagement or ownership?

## 3. Leadership Lens

- If my role is to lead learning rather than manage behavior, what changes?
- What obstacle might be getting in the way of learning right now?

## 4. Servant Leadership Reflection

- How can I better serve my students this week?
- What conditions can I create to support ownership instead of dependence?

## 5. Action Commitment

- One leadership shift I will try this week: \_\_\_\_\_
- One question I will ask students more often: \_\_\_\_\_
- One behavior I will stop managing and start leading: \_\_\_\_\_
