WHAT IS PESACH

Pesach is the memorial of deliverance.

Shemoth 12:13

“When I see the blood, I shall pass over you...”

YAHUAH delivered His people
out of Mitsrayim.

This is what we remember.

Echoes of YAHUAH™

WHEN IT HAPPENS

Pesach

14th day of the first month (Aviv) at evening

Wayyiqra 23:5

Unleavened Bread

7 days

Wayyiqra 23:6

Pesach begins the cycle.
Unleavened Bread continues it.

WHAT TO REMOVE

Shemoth 12:15

“For seven days you shall eat unleavened
bread...
remove leaven from your house”

Remove leaven:

Leavened bread

Yeast

Sourdough starter

Leavened baked goods

Leaven is what causes bread to rise.

Stay in Torah, not fear.

WHAT TO EAT

Shemoth 12:15

“For seven days you shall eat unleavened bread...”

Eat freely:

Unleavened bread

Meat

Eggs

Vegetables

Fruit

Clean foods are allowed.
The only restriction is leaven.

This is simplicity, not burden..

Echoes of YAHUAH™

WHAT TO DO

Shemoth (Exodus) 12:8

“They shall eat the flesh that night, roasted in fire, with unleavened bread...”

At evening (beginning of the 14th):

Prepare a simple meal

Eat unleavened bread

Eat clean food

Remember:

This is a memorial

Speak of what YAHUAH has done

Reflect on deliverance

If you cannot do everything:

Obey what you understand.

Walk it sincere.

This is remembrance, not performance.

CHAG HAMATZOT

Shemoth (Exodus) 12:15

“They shall eat the flesh that night, roasted in fire, with unleavened bread...”

Wayyiqra (Leviticus) 23:6

“On the fifteenth day... is the Festival of Unleavened Bread... seven days you shall eat unleavened bread.”

What this means:

Begins after Pesach

Lasts 7 days

No leaven is to be eaten

What to do:

Eat unleavened bread daily

Continue removing leaven

Stay focused on obedience

What it represents:

Leaven represents corruption and sin.

Unleavened represents purity and truth.

Remove what corrupts. Walk in what is clean.

BIKKURIM

Wayyiqra (Leviticus) 23:10–11

“When you come into the land... and reap its harvest,
then you shall bring a sheaf of the first fruits...
and he shall wave the sheaf... to be accepted for you.”

What it is:

The first of the harvest
Given to YAHUAH first
An offering of acknowledgment

When it happens:

During Unleavened Bread
At the beginning of the harvest

What it means:

The first belongs to YAHUAH.
What comes first sets the order.

Honor YAHUAH first. Everything else will follow.

WALK IT OUT

Ya'aqov 1:22

“Be doers of the word, and not hearers only.”

**You have learned:
Now it is time to walk it.**

What Pesach is
What to remove
What to eat
What to do
What to continue
What comes first

Now do it:

**Obey what is written.
Keep it simple.
Walk in truth.**

Encouragement:

You do not need perfection.
You need obedience.

Hear. Obey. Walk it out.
