- 1. You, the foster, agree to care for the reptile properly, including proper enclosure size, set up, proper lighting, temperature checks with temperature gun, daily water changes, proper feeding schedule of approved greens, appropriately sized feeders (including rats, mice, mealworms, super worms, dubia roaches, hornworms, and other approved feeders.)
- 2. NTRR will provide enclosure, UVB, heat source, water/food bowls, insects for our insectivores, and frozen thawed rats/mice for the 1st month. Snakes: we will provide frozen thawed rats/mice for the 1st month (2 feeder mice/rats). As a foster, you are financially responsible for any other food. If any lights burn out you may contact NTRR and we can order lights and ship directly to your home.
- 3. As a rescue we are able to rehabilitate these amazing reptiles because of our foster community. We are truly grateful. Detailed instruction list on care and husbandry will be provided for the reptile you are fostering. Detailed list of supplies belonging to NTRR will be included and both agent and foster will review the list and initial all items. When fostering you can choose how long you wish to foster. If it becomes a foster fail we give a discounted rate for the adoption fee.
- 4. You, as the foster, agree to care for the reptile in a humane manner and maintain all care in your home. You agree not to sell, trade or give away the foster. If the reptile suddenly passes away NTRR will be notified within 3 hours of death. Please place the remains in a zip lock bag and palace in the freezer. The pet's remains will be picked up by a rescue agent. Please do not dispose or bury the remains.
- 5. If your reptile is showing signs of illness, please contact us, within 24 hours via NTRR Facebook page so we can take it to the exotic vet. Michelle Crow, Stephanie Moses,

- Aimee Zissa or another one of our amazing board members will respond in a timely manner.
- 6. NTRR and its agents will not be held responsible for any accidents, injuries, or illnesses arising for the fostering of our rescue reptiles. The foster hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for, and agrees to indemnify and hold NTRR harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of liability imposed by law upon NTRR or any of its officers, directors, members, employees, representatives, agents, or assigns because of bodily injuries or death to any person or persons including foster or those in the foster's household. Or any damage to property and/or animals arising out of or in consequence of the placement of the reptile howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property and/or animals bay be caused, whether or not the same may have been caused, or may be alleged to have been accused, by negligence of the aforementioned parties, or any of their directors, members, employees, representatives, agents, or assigns of any other person.
