- Acquired an historic building on Main Street

Did you know that Norwegian Ridge (Spring Grove) is run by numerous Nisser, Gnomes and Trolls? It takes a number of people to make our commu-

nity run smoothly. For years you may have seen many adults working to keep the street clean and the businesses running smoothly.

Recently it has been discovered that those people have had some hidden, secret helpers. You have to look carefully to see them at work. During spring, summer and fall they are hidden by the leaves on trees and bushes. However, in the winter you may just see their homes peeking out around the rocks, stumps and trees. They are creatures hiding in parks and gardens. The caretakers of Giants' Pioneer Garden have discovered the doors and windows of their homes. Stroll through the garden and you may find them too. THE 6TH GRADE ACADEMIES CONTINUE

In September, Bill traveled to Mabel-Canton Elementary to introduce the 6th Grade Academy concept to this years 6th graders in Mabel. The students listen carefully wholly unaware of the adventure they were about to begin. For decades, the Minnesota Department of Education has required 6th grade students in Minnesota to study the history of their home, Minnesota. Giants mission statement also hopes to teach the students of the area about their immigrant story. While the program began in Spring Grove it has expanded to Houston and Mabel-Canton school Districts.

For 10 weeks, students learn about the 19th and 20th century history of North America. Students also explore world history which motivated people to immigrate

to southeastern Minnesota. Once a week sessions are presented and students are mentored to discover their family's unique story.

A celebration is held at Giants and students display their work in our galleries. This year they



displayed 22 trifold boards which tell their stories. The next project is scheduled to begin in mid February with this year's Spring Grove students. Their work will be exhibited over Syttende Mai weekend. Well done, Bill!


