

**Basic rules** for submitting projected images:

1. A projected image may be submitted only once for monthly club competition. An images that was previously submitted as a print may be submitted as a projected image in a subsequent calendar year.
2. You can submit up to a combined total of 4 images, including prints and projected images.
3. Entry slip. A separate entry slip is required for each image. The entry slip must be filled out and submitted at or before the meeting at which the images is to be displayed. Entry slips should be purchased in advance. The entry slip number is part of the digital image file name.

Format for projected Images:

1. Maximum image size: **Horizontal images** will be no more than **1400 pixels wide or 1050 pixels tall. Vertical images** will be no more than **1050 pixels tall**. Unless your image proportions are in the exact ratio of 4 to 3, one of these dimensions will be less than the maximum.
2. Color Space: **sRGB color space** is recommended for optimum results.
3. File type: JPEG
4. File naming conventions - The file name of **each image** should include
  - a. the image name,
  - b. the photographer's name,
  - c. the image category,
  - d. the entry slip number, and
  - e. the month and year in which the image will be displayed.

Here is one example of a file name:

Green Tree by Jane Doe Gen Entry #9586, July 2019.JPG.
