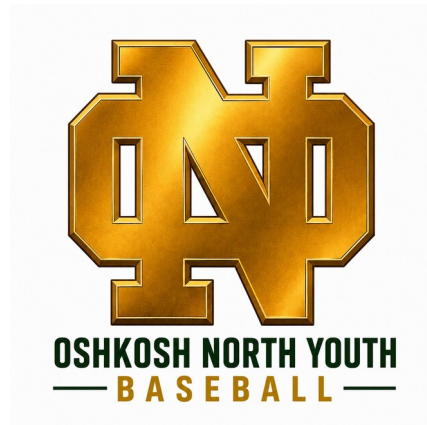




Parent & Player Agreement

Participation in Oshkosh North Youth Baseball (ONYB) is a privilege. Our organization is committed to providing every athlete with a safe, structured, positive, and competitive environment where they can grow as players and as individuals.

Every player, parent, coach, volunteer, and spectator plays an important role in maintaining the culture of our program. This agreement establishes the expectations that help us create an environment built upon respect, accountability, teamwork, sportsmanship, and excellence.

All players and parents must review and sign this agreement prior to participating in team activities.

PLAYER EXPECTATIONS

Attendance & Preparedness

- Wear the complete team uniform correctly.
- Bring all required equipment.
- Have water and any necessary personal items.
- Notify their coach as early as possible if they will be late or absent.

Commitment to the Team

- Put team success before individual recognition.
- Encourage and support teammates.
- Demonstrate positive sportsmanship.
- Maintain a positive attitude during both success and adversity.

Personal Responsibility

- Help maintain an organized dugout.
- Assist with team equipment.
- Respect facilities.
- Remain with the team from pregame warmups through the conclusion of the post-game meeting unless released by a coach.

Effort & Coachability

- Hustle at all times.
- Compete with maximum effort.
- Listen to instruction.

- Be coachable.
- Display a positive attitude regardless of playing time or position.
- Effort and attitude are always within a player's control.

Respect

- Treat teammates, opponents, officials, coaches, volunteers, parents, and spectators with respect.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct, profanity, bullying, or disrespectful behavior will not be tolerated.

PARENT EXPECTATIONS

Positive Communication

- Communicate respectfully with coaches, volunteers, officials, and other families.
- Constructive conversations should always occur professionally.

24-Hour Rule

- Wait at least 24 hours before discussing playing time, positions, coaching decisions, discipline, or game strategy.

Attendance & Commitment

- Prioritize attendance whenever possible.
- Notify coaches promptly of scheduling conflicts.
- Support team commitments throughout the season.

Dugout, Field & Coaching Expectations

- Parents, family members, friends, and spectators are not permitted in the dugout, on the field, or inside team areas unless invited by an ONYB coach or game official.
- If a player is injured or requires parental assistance, a coach will promptly notify and escort the parent or guardian.
- Parents should remain in designated spectator areas during practices and games.

Sideline Coaching

- Parents, family members, and spectators should refrain from sideline coaching.
- Positive encouragement is always welcome.
- Instruction regarding mechanics, positioning, strategy, and decision-making should be left to ONYB coaches.
- Parents are encouraged to be their child's biggest supporter—not their coach.

Sportsmanship & Representing ONYB

- Display Integrity, Accountability, Respect, Pride, Teamwork, and Positive Sportsmanship.
- Negative interactions with officials, opponents, volunteers, or spectators will not be tolerated.

Our Commitment

- Develop confidence, leadership, discipline, responsibility, teamwork, and character.
- Our goal is to develop outstanding young people—not just better baseball players.
