"THE TRAIL" TO DHR



CHOCOLATE EXTREME AKA "SNICKERS"

Snickers is a 20-year old Registered Rocky Mountain mare. She is from the founding lineage of "Tobe" for this rare breed developed in the Appalachian Mountains of Kentucky in the early 20th century. She has a wonderful disposition, but is known as the "Princess of the Pasture" and loves to be pampered. She is always ready for a treat and enjoys being groomed with a good brushing.

CLASSY BLUE COMET AKA "BLUE"

Blue is an 8-year old Registered Paint mare. She has an impeccable pedigree in the "cutting world" for horses with being sired from "Forest Midnight Comet", a 2-time world working cow horse champion and top ten world-reining champion. She loves people and is extremely curious about what you are up to at the ranch. Blue has a great personality, but can have an attitude of a 5-year old at times.

DE MAYOS SON AKA "DE" OR "DE MAN"

De Mayos is a 14-year old Registered American Quarter Horse gelding who was rescued from the kill pen in Stroud, OK. He came from a huge working ranch in Oklahoma, but was eventually thrown away by his owner - like many of his herd. He most likely was a cutting horse for the ranch which is why we often times catch him watching the cows in the next pasture over. De Mayos has a wonderful sweet personality and will come running to greet you each time you are headed to the pasture or call his name. He has proven to be a good boy and extremely loveable.

Ernie is an 11-year old standard guard donkey standing 45 inches high who was rescued from the kill pen in Stroud, OK. He was extremely abused and not handled much by his owners. - \$25/night for tent camping

- \$10/person/per day Bicycles male and female styles.
- \$25/night Camping Tent 6-person tent includes sleeping bed and bedding. Must have 24-hour notice for set up.
- \$10/hr or \$30 per day Arena Riding
