

Glazing Maintenance Guide

Full Cleaning & Care Guide

GENERAL CARE PRINCIPLES (ALL ALUMINIUM PRODUCTS)

USE:

- Warm Water + pH-neutral detergent
- Microfiber cloths
- Silicone-based lubricant for tracks

AVOID:

- Abrasives
- Solvents or bleach
- High-pressure washers
- WD-40 or oil-based lubricants

SLIDING DOORS:

- Frames & Glass: Clean with mild soapy water
- Tracks: Vacuum debris, wash, dry, apply silicone spray lightly
- Seals: Warm soapy water only

BIFOLD DOORS:

- Frames & Glass: Mild soapy water
- Hinges: Light silicone every 6 months
- Bottom track: Vacuum, clean, silicone spray
- Seals: Warm soapy water only

ENTRANCE DOORS:

- Frames & Glass: Mild soapy water
- Hardware: Mild soap only; light silicone on latches every 6 months
- Seals: Warm soapy water only

ALUMINIUM WINDOWS:

- Frames & Glass: Mild soapy water
- Friction Hinges: Light silicone on pivots only
- Loks: Light silicone every 6 months
- Drainage slots: Check every 3-6 months

FREQUENCY:

- External: Every 1-3 months
- Internal: Every 3 months
- Moving Parts: Every 6 months



WEATHER SEALS & GASKETS:

- Warm water + mild detergent only
- Avoid chemicals
- Check seating every 3-6 months

ROUTINE MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE (DETAILED):

- External frame cleaning: 1-3 months
- Internal frame cleaning: 3 months
- Track vacuuming: Monthly
- Lubrication: Every 6 months
- Drainage checks: Every 3-6 months


IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Regular light cleaning is preferred.
- Abrasives damage coatings
- Tracks must remain free from grit
- Only use silicone-based lubricants
- Report operational issues promptly
