The Mendenhall Ministries, an outreach of the Mendenhall Bible Church, seeks nominations of and applications from Christian leaders for consideration as candidates for president.

We will accept applications through August 1, 2026 and plan to make a decision by September 1, 2026; however, this window may close earlier if a qualified and acceptable candidate is found.

The Mendenhall Ministries, which began as Voice of Calvary Ministries under the leadership of Dr. John Perkins in the 1970's, has been led since then by Pastor Artis Fletcher, pastor-emeritus of Mendenhall Bible Church, and several presidents, including Dr. Dolphus Weary. The current vacancy arose when Dr. Scottye Holloway, president for the last eight years, accepted a call to pastor a church in Jackson, Mississippi.

The vision of TMM is to provide Christian-based services to the needy in our rural Mississippi community in the areas of education, health care, elderly care, education, youth programs, volunteer experiences, and community development projects. We are currently developing plans to create sustainable projects, especially using the church membership's 120 acre farm. These efforts have been funded by faithful donors, donor-churches and foundations.

President Profile and Skills Needed

The ideal candidate for President of TMM will be a born-again Christian, preferably an ordained minister, who can communicate their faith and the work of TMM with individuals from all walks of life.

The President is the chief fund-raiser and representative of TMM who travels nationally and interacts with local and state leaders to articulate the ministry's goals and projects, while also interacting with the community TMM serves and developing projects to meet their needs.

The President is accountable to TMM's Board of Directors with whom the president must maintain positive, open, and honest communications.

The President is responsible for TMM finances, including overseeing the budget, developing fund-raising strategies, and insuring the fiscal health of the organization, including the submission of all reports that are required of the state and federal government.

The President is also responsible for the day to day operations of TMM's projects, including staff training and development and coordination of volunteers' assistance. The President is also responsible for the development of short and long-term plans for projects to meet needs on the community.

Work Environment

- TMM is located in Mendenhall, Mississippi, approximately 40 miles south of Jackson, Mississippi, the state's capital.
- The president and his or her family must live in Simpson County, preferably in Mendenhall. Housing can be provided, given the need and properties available.
- TMM's campus is located on church property in the minority community.
- TMM is in the process of rebuilding programs and adding staff and the president will assist in that effort.
- Because TMM is intimately tied to the Mendenhall Bible Church, it is expected that the president will become a regular or associate member of MBC, meet regularly with the elder board, and participate in all MBC activities, including services.
