The Deb Dart Memorial Scholarship is seeking high school senior women golfers that have made a positive impact on their community through volunteering! Deb Dart helped start the girls' golf program at Comstock High School. In addition, she strongly supported the Comstock Community through various volunteer activities, even during her chemotherapy treatments. She passed away in 2005 after losing her second fight with breast cancer.

Her son and daughter both graduated from Comstock High School, and to honor her fighting spirit, dedication to community, and passion for golf they have established a scholarship of \$500.00 to be awarded annually to a female golfer to honor her memory.

CRITERIA TO QUALIFY FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP WILL INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

- Comstock High School senior girl who played on the golf team.
- Applicants must possess a 2.8 GPA through seven semesters and include transcripts.
- Applicants must have volunteered in some capacity in the community.
