Driver Fitting Interview And Driver Score Cards

The golfer needs to think out the information they want to discuss with the clubfitter. The clubfitter may also have a short form to fill out like the example shown here for a "Personal Interview" which will indicate the golfer's driver hitting tendencies along with any of their goals, wants and preferences. Also, it is recommended that any golfer wanting to get fit for a new driver fill out 3 or more "Driver Score Cards" on page 649. These cards provide actual playing information which is quickly and easily analyzed to point out the golfer's possible strengths and weaknesses. However, more importantly, they help with the approach the clubfitter needs to take to correct any faults and/or satisfy the golfer's wants or needs. So, a good, straight forward Personal Interview between the clubfitter and the golfer is a necessity for a good driver fitting session.
