MEMORANDUM

1. The Society shall be called, "The Indian Society of Criminology and its headquarters shall be in Madras,
2. It shall be a public charitable (educational) institution dedicated to the following objects:
 - a) to advance the study, research and application of Criminology and allied sciences for the welfare of society;
 - b) to promote the organisation and utilisation of criminological research, education and services,
 - c) to facilitate co-operation among persons and institutions interested in the study of the phenomena of crime and criminal behaviour:
 - d) to co-operate with other Societies having similar or allied interests:
 - e) to establish local branches of the Society in other centres in the country and
 - f) to carry on such activities as deemed necessary to promote the objects of the Society.
3. The Society may raise funds through subscriptions from members and donations and grants from other individuals, institutions or Governments, in furtherance of the Society's activities designed to achieve its objectives.
4. The income and property of the Society, however and whenever derived, shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the Society set forth in the memorandum of the Society and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise by way of profit to the members of the Society: provided that nothing herein shall prevent the payment in good faith of reasonable and proper remuneration to any member of the Society in return for any service actually rendered to the Society.
5. The Society may acquire any movable or immovable property. rights and privileges on such terms and conditions not inconsistent with the foregoing objects; for this purpose, the Society may also borrow or raise funds on such security as appropriate.
