The Law Enforcement Safety Act (LEOSA), Title 18 USC 926 c, AKA HR 218 seems to get more and more convoluted as time goes on. It was stated if you have "HR 218" there is no need to retain your NYPD issued NYC Pistol License, that you may "carry" country wide. Suggesting that "HR 218" supersedes your NYC Pistol License. That being said consider if you give up your NYC Pistol License, you no longer have a means to buy or sell a sidearm as a NYC resident. NYC requires you to have <u>registered</u> side arm with a pistol permit holder in order to sell. Not just the ability to carry. The same applies to purchasing a side arm. In NYC a "FFL" dealer must deal with a pistol permit holder to sell/transfer the side arm to.

- 1. There is an Enhanced Star Program if you are 56 years old.
- 2. You should be getting a refund check for your property taxes this fall. The amount depends on your income.
- 3. Seniors should file for income verification at their assessor's office.
- You have to apply each year to verify your income to apply for exemptions to reduce your property tax.
- All applications for exemptions must be filed before March 1st.
- 6. You can take multiple exemptions.
