

Hello all,

By now, everyone should have received their last quarterly Pension statement. Quarterly statements will no longer be issued, annual statements only. So, how do I get me information?

These Step By Step Instructions, Excerpted From The RSA's latest Chevron Publication Should Be Helpful.

### **HOW DO I GET MY PENSION INFORMATION?**

If you're looking for information regarding your pension, the city has a website that does just that. It's called webCOPS. It's part of the NYC Police Pension Fund system. WebCOPS is a secure website that supplies you with basic information. You can, however, request a variety of information from the site such as Pension Statements, Loan Estimates and Tax statements.

To begin, you first need to call the Pension Section at (646) 905-5596 to get a Pin # to activate your account. You will be mailed a Pin # for registration. Make sure they have your current address on file. You will be mailed a Pin # for registration.

When you receive your Pin #, go to the website and create an account.

Note, there is an expiration date on the Pin #.

### WHEN ON THE WEBPAGE, DO THE FOLLOWING:

- Click "create an account" and log directly into your webCOPS Member Self-Service portal. It will bring you to a sign-in page.
- Click the "Register" Button.
- Accept the terms of agreement.
- Select "Primary Member."
- Fill in your information such as your SS # and Tax # to complete form.
- Click on "I Am Human" Button and answer the question.
- Click on the "Next" Button.
- Select your Security questions. Answer the questions and write them down for future reference.
- Click on the "Next" Button.
- The next page requires you to enter your Pin # mailed by the Pension Section.
- Click on the "Complete" Button.
- Set up Two Factor Authorization. It asks for your phone number and email address.
- It asks if you want paperless notification or mail notification. Select your preference.
- Click on "Finish" and you will be registered and in their Document Page. You're Done.



#### **APPLICATION**

Extra Copies of the application may be obtained at our website VZ1013.com or it can be duplicated (see below). Non-conforming applications will be discarded.

#### **SPONSOR**

Applicants must be sponsored by a member of Verrazano 10-13 Association in good standing for the past two (2) years. A sponsor may submit multiple applications for different children. However, a sponsor is limited to only one scholarship award every two (2) consecutive yearly drawings.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

A son, daughter or grandchild of a member is eligible for a scholarship and must be attending or enrolled in a paid tuition College or University on a full-time basis (taking at least 12 credits) for the school year. Each child can only win once, but a member can sponsor another child after waiting (2) years. ONLY ONE ENTRY PER APPLICANT IS PERMITTED. 


