You will have to provide the Deceased's First, Middle and Last name, the date of death, social security number, next of kin as well as the executor/trix of the estate and his/her address and phone number.

To complete our records you will need a COPY of the will, a copy of the paid funeral bill, the original or certified copy of the Death certificate and Marriage certificate as well as SPOUSE Social Security #. These documents are necessary for any benefits that might be due you as per the member chosen options.

They will send the surviving spouse a pre-number application allowing the spouse to continue the health coverage that the member had at a cost equal to 102% of what the City pays, which includes admin fees.

GENERAL GUIDE FOR THE WIDOW/WIDOWER OF A RETIRED MOS

From the Pension Rep:

THE BELOW ARTICLE WAS WRITTEN BY MARIE BRUSCO AND LINDA LACHICK NYC POLICE PENSION FUND Few situations in life are more stressful than when a spouse passes. All too often we have a difficult time focusing on the issues at hand and need guidance to get the deceased affairs in order. The following is a general guide for the widow/er regarding important notifications that must be made by the surviving spouse and information you should have on hand when a retiree dies.

FIRST STEPS TO BE TAKEN AFTER DEATH NOTIFICATIONS

- 1) Operations Unit 646-610-5580 calling to report the death of a retired police officer and are requesting NYCPD FLAG for casket & Pallbearers for his funeral. IN (all five boroughs, all of Long Island and Upstate New York but NOT beyond Dutchess County.) Can ALSO Request DEPT FLAG for funerals OUTSIDE of above areas. Give FIRST, MIDDLE and LAST NAME, DATE OF DEATH, SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER LAST 6 NUMBERS, MEMBERS TAX #, RANK, LAST COMMAND, NEXT of KIN.
- 2) Notify the NYC Police Pension Fund (PPF) either in writing OR or by telephone. This Number is Just For Death Benefits (212) 693-6887. Attn: Retiree Death Benefits 233 Broadway, 25th Floor New York NY 10279
- 3) Contact the appropriate UNION for a possible existing LIFE insurance policy AND also for Continuation of Optional benefits, Any Questions about the Fund provided or your right to benefits under a particular Fund, contact Fund Administrator at the Fund address shown below:

4) Contact the NYC HEALTH Benefits Program for Special Continuation of Coverage Application (Coverage for LIFE) located at (NEW) 22 Cortland St. 12th Floor, New York, NY 10007: NEW (212) 306-7200 (Gen Info) When Writing: Send Certified w/Return Receipt, SS # on top of every page.

There are no words of comfort at such a difficult time, however if you have all the necessary information at the ready it will expedite any claim that is pending, make the process run smoothly and your stress level can be minimized.

I would like to thank our National NYCPD 10-13 Chapters, membership and friends, who contribute to our organization by consistently supporting the National Annual Convention and our "Mega Prize Drawing." I would also like to thank our Chapters, who contribute and support the National NYCPD 10-13, by paying their membership dues on time.

The "Mega Prize Drawing" will contribute greatly in keeping the National's books in the black, as well as the pocketbooks of the 19 lucky winners. In addition, the National 10-13 Chapter which sells the winning 1st Prize ticket will receive \$1,000.00 and the chapter selling the 2nd Prize ticket will receive \$500.00. The proceeds that are received by the National NYCPD 10-13 will allow us greater latitude to engage with legislators in Albany and New York City, making our voices and needs heard. And in protecting, enhancing and gaining our retirees much deserved benefits. Many legislators fail to remember or report that our benefits were gained in lieu of raises and other enhancements for which we contractually negotiated.

The Bills that we are supporting during the 2025 NYS Legislative Session are: Health Protection Bill (S-3607), the COLA Enhancement Bills and the Veteran's Supplementation Bill. The session began in January for the year 2025. All legislative bills have been re-introduced and are pending numbers, with the exception of the Health Benefit Bill. As soon as the bills are numbered, they will be added to the National Agenda and a Memoranda of Support will be submitted for each legislative bill.

The National NYCPD 10-13 is recognized by our elected officials. Our reputation, as the voice for NYPD retirees, is respected by those in power, as we continue to consult with them.

Many of our retirees are unaware of legislative attempted changes to our earned benefits, which will affect Civil Service Retirees all over the country. This is the reason the National NYCPD 10-13 was formed, so that NYC Police Retirees throughout the country have a voice in New York, and for your protection, a pro-active legislative agenda by the National. Our dues structure is \$1.00 per member. Most Chapters involved in the "Mega Prize Drawing" recuperate their dues and gain a profit due to the rebate. This gives the National an opportunity to be involved with legislation through its membership in the Alliance of Public Retirees of NY, Memoranda of Support letters, meetings and phone calls to our elected officials in New York State.

The NYCPD Verrazano 10-13 Memorial High School & College Scholarship Award Application

APPLICATION

Extra Copies of the application may be obtained at our website VZ1013.com or it can be duplicated (see below). Non-conforming applications will be discarded.

SPONSOR

Applicants must be sponsored by a member of Verrazano 10-13 Association in good standing for the past two (2) years. A sponsor may submit multiple applications for different children. However, a sponsor is limited to only one scholarship award every two (2) consecutive yearly drawings.

ELIGIBILITY

A son, daughter or grandchild of a member is eligible for a scholarship and must be attending or enrolled in a paid tuition College or University on a full-time basis (taking at least 12 credits) for the school year. Each child can only win once, but a member can sponsor another child after waiting (2) years. ONLY ONE ENTRY PER APPLICANT IS PERMITTED. If more than one application is received for the same applicant, all but one will be discarded.

VERIFICATION OF ATTENDANCE
