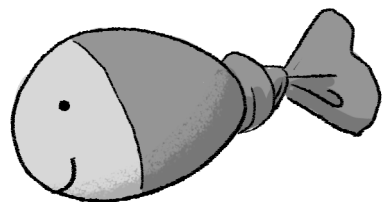
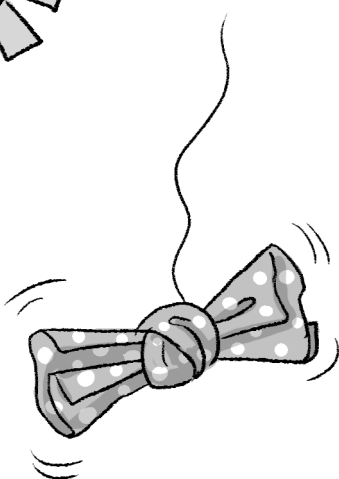


Most kitties love to play. You can buy cat toys at the store but it's more fun to make them yourself!

Knot a strip of fleece fabric and tie to a string.

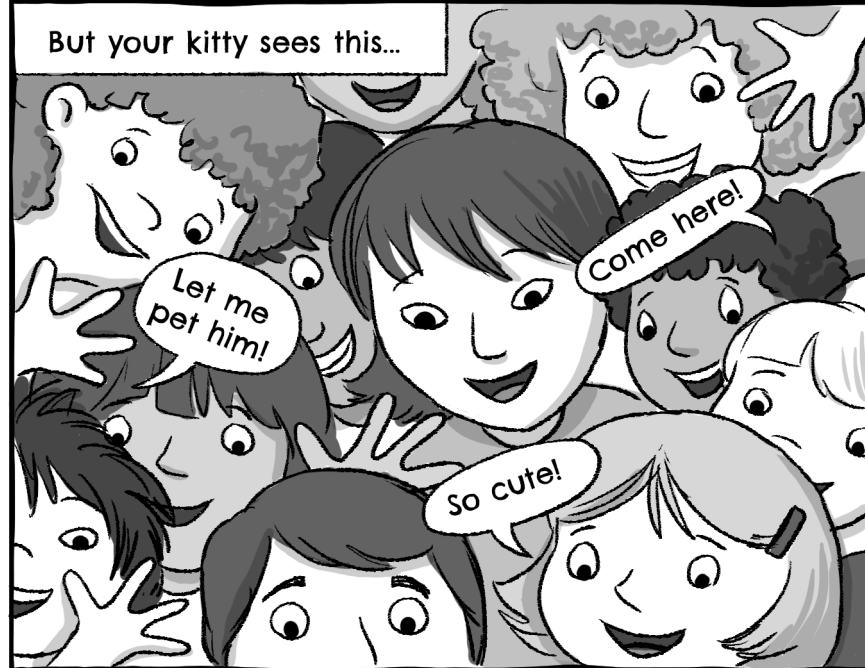


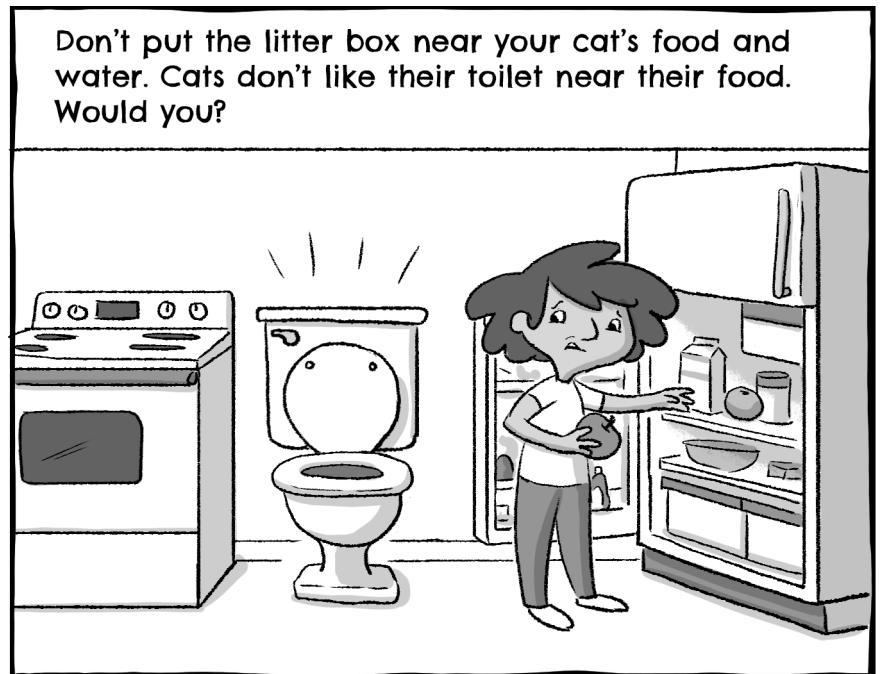
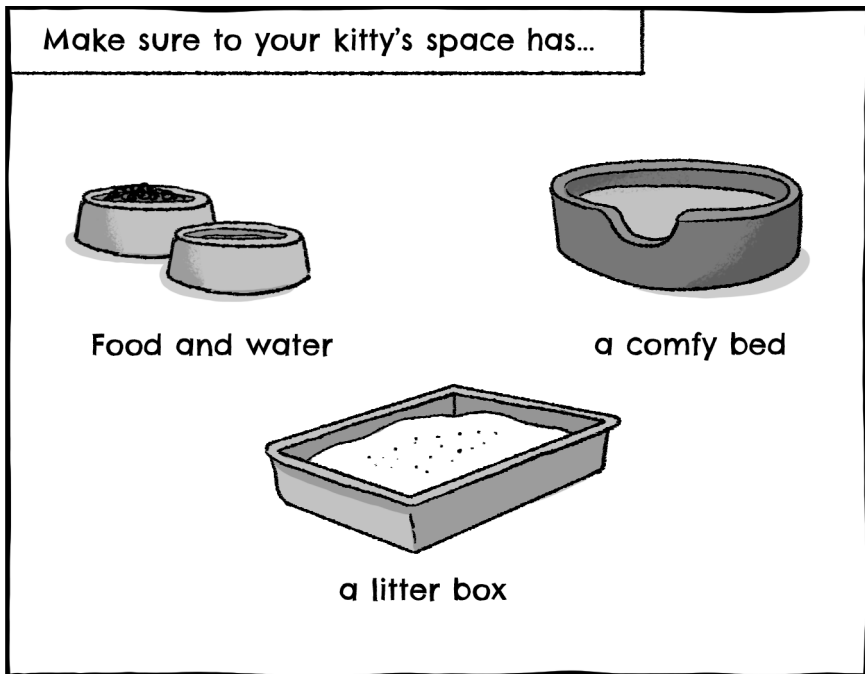
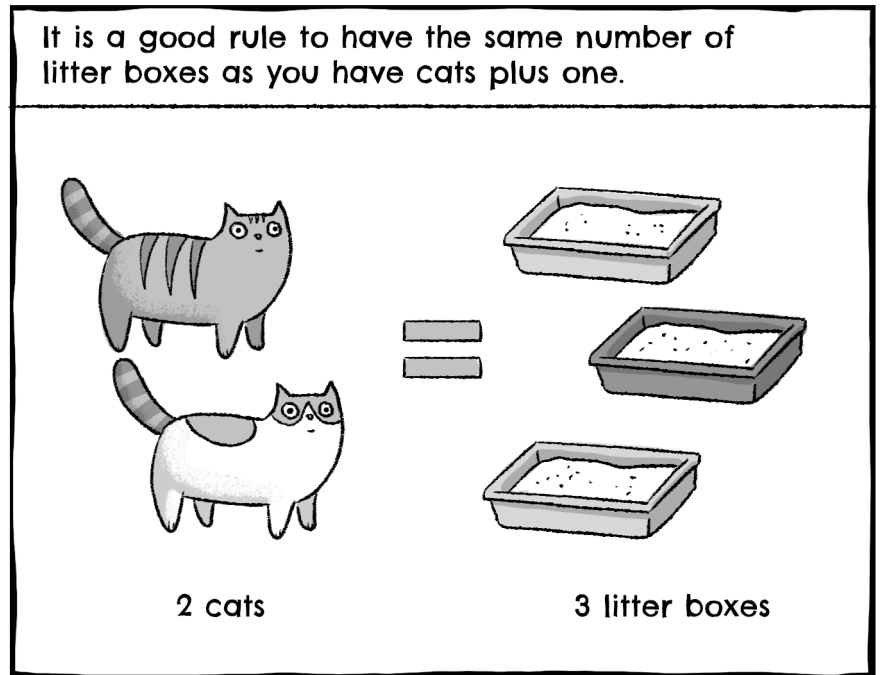
Cut the toe off an old sock. Fill it with catnip and tie shut. Draw a face on it for a fun and fishy toy.

Be patient with your pet. Remember, you see this...

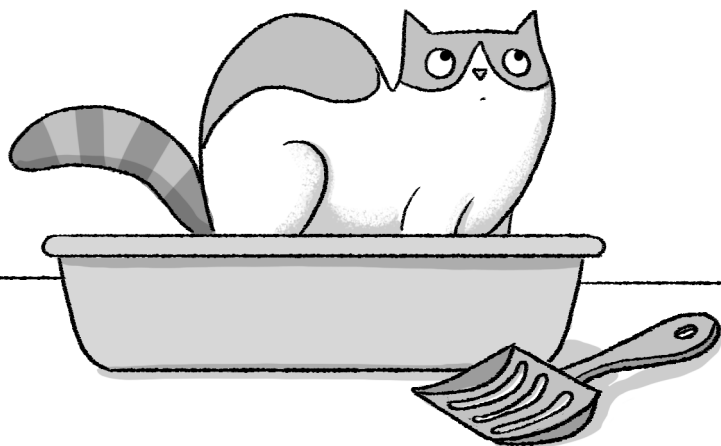


But your kitty sees this...





Cats go to the bathroom in a litter box. Give your kitty at least one.



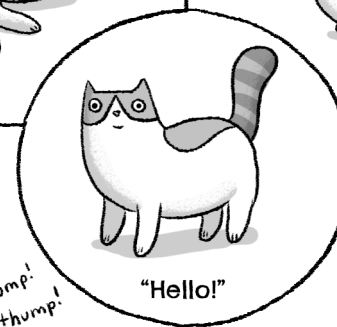
Cats can't talk like people. They use their bodies to tell you how they feel. Learn to talk like a cat!

"I'm annoyed"

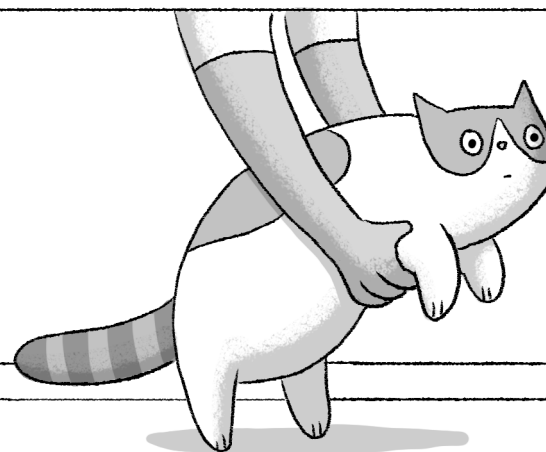

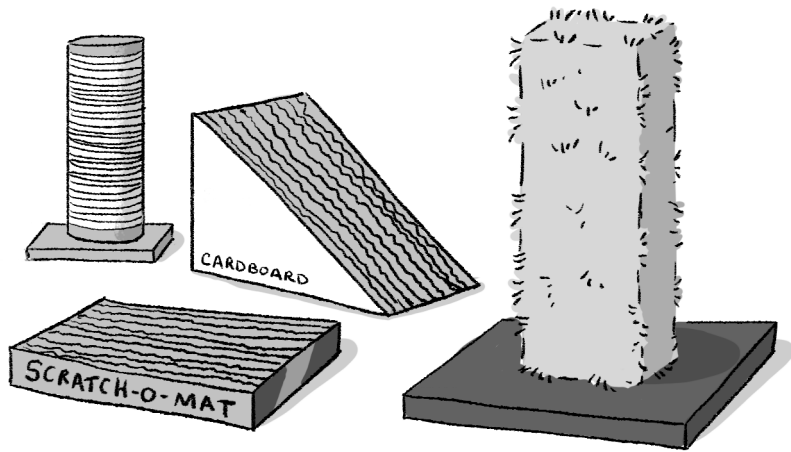
Keep their box clean. Scoop out the dirty litter every day.

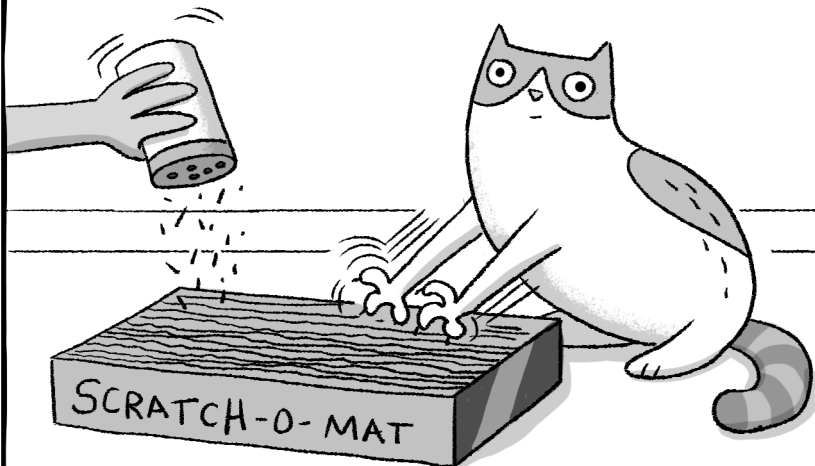

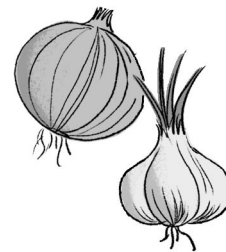


A little cat nip will encourage them to scratch here...

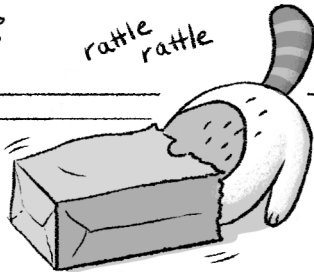


Cats are very curious and can injure themselves. Here are some ways to make your home kitty safe.



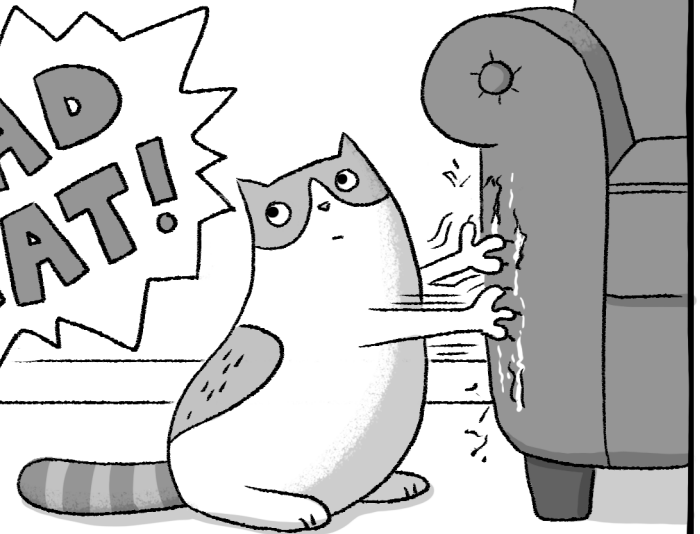
Cats can play with paper bags, but NEVER give them plastic ones. They could choke.

...and not here.

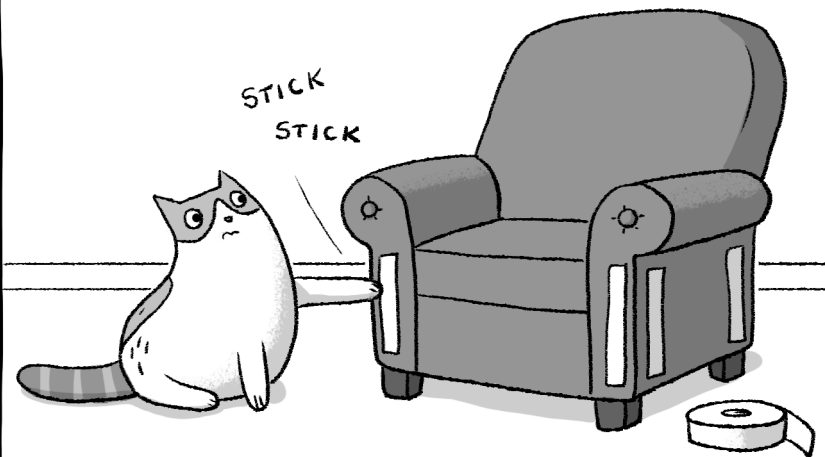
BAD CAT!



Remove or secure cords on blinds and curtains. Cats can get tangled and hurt themselves.



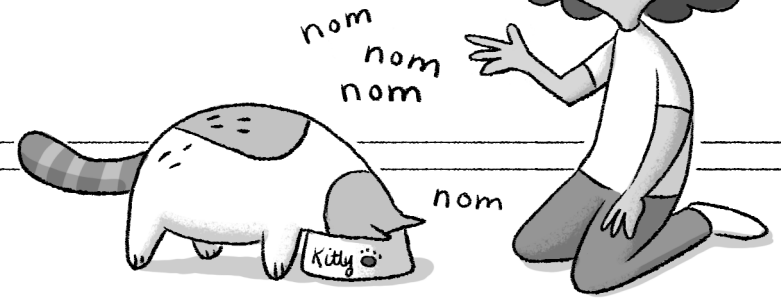
Cats don't like to get their paws sticky. Covering the edges of sofas in chairs with double stick tape will help keep them claw free.
