




















Cats need to scratch to keep their claws healthy.

Give them plenty of things to dig their claws into.







































Most kitties love to play. You can buy cat toys at the store but it's more fun to make them yourself!



Make cuts in the end of a toilet paper tube and bend outwards.






Cut the toe off an old sock. Fill it with catnip and tie shut. Draw a face on it for a fun and fishy toy.




Make a puzzle toy out of a clean pizza box.


