In recent days we have been asked multiple questions regarding the COVID -19 response and responsibility when it comes to payment of rent and the suspension of evictions. I wanted to take this opportunity to clarify that nothing has changed as far as your responsibility to pay rent. In order to ensure that no one is displaced during this epidemic, there has been a suspension of evictions, but that in no way affects the duty to pay rent. Any decreases in income should be reported to BHA office immediately so changes to rent portions can be effective the following month of change.

This is a fluid situation that is changing daily, we thank you in advance for your continued patience, understanding and flexibility.

BHA has implemented these items to ensure the safety of the communities we serve, its residents and its employees.
