

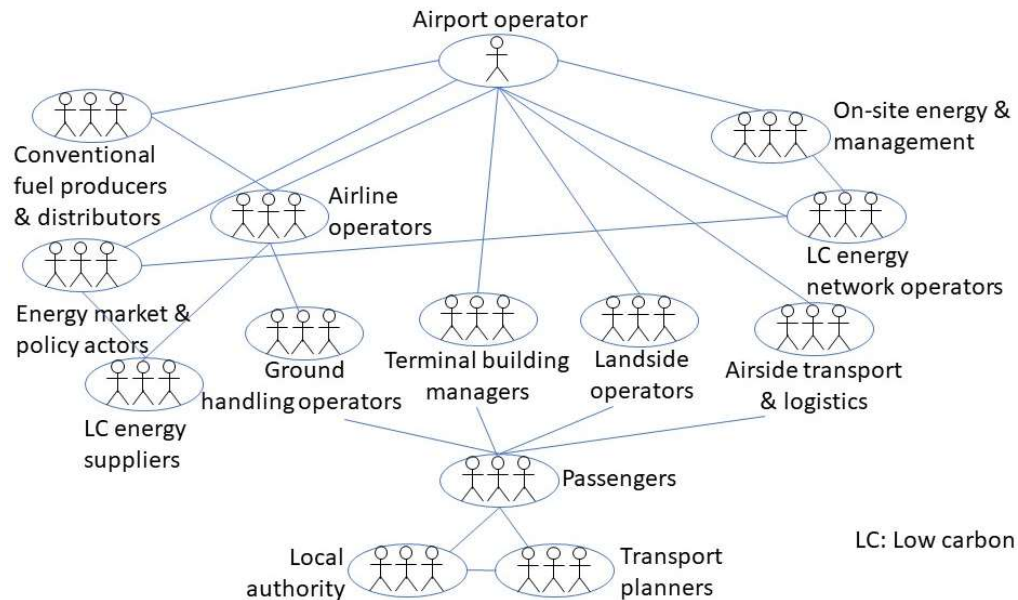
## Multi-Actor Governance framework for the electrification of airports (MAGIC)

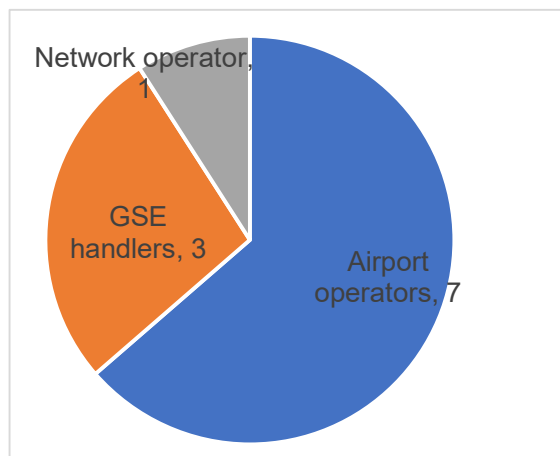

MAGIC aims to develop a multi-actor governance framework for airports that can enable cost-effective management of new electrical loads via electrification of ground services by considering conflicting interests, politics and discordance about the allocation of costs and benefits across different actors (see Figure 1).
