This positive reinforcement not only motivates students to perform well in school, but also promotes emotional well-being and resilience (Hill & Tyson, 2009).

Improved Communication with Teachers. Effective communication between teachers and parents is essential for monitoring a child's progress and addressing any academic concerns promptly. When parents maintain open lines of communication with educators, they gain valuable insights into their child's strengths and weaknesses, allowing for targeted intervention strategies to be implemented. Research by Hoover-Dempsey and Sandler (2005) highlights facilitating collaboration between home and school, ultimately leading to better academic outcomes for students.

Increased Academic Aspirations. Parental involvement has been linked to higher academic aspirations among children. When parents actively engage in discussions about future goals and career aspirations, they inspire their children to aim for academic excellence and pursue higher education opportunities. This proactive approach to planning for the future instills a sense of purpose and direction in students, motivating them to strive for success.
