




discovering new patterns cultivates creativity, which is crucial for innovation in fields such as technology, engineering, and the arts.

Research Abstract

Utilization of Functional Literacy Assessment Tool (FLAT) among Grade Seven Students in a Secondary School in the City of Taguig: Basis for an Intervention Program by Maricris B. Popanes



Reading has a huge impact on the performance of students and every institution. To address the reading difficulties of struggling readers, the school should take the initiative in creating a stabilized reading intervention program that will benefit the learners at the forefront of any educational paradigm.

The study used the descriptive quantitative method, using the Functional Literacy Assessment Tool (FLAT) for the pretest and post-test. It had two groups of respondents composed of 30 grade 7 students and a survey questionnaire for the 19 grade 7 teachers. The data were statistically treated using frequency, percentage, weighted mean, ranking, and the Chisquare test


The study's findings showed that in terms of the demographic profile of the grade 7 students, most of the student-respondents are 13 years old, male, speak Filipino, have an income of 5,000-9,999, and are not part of an ethnic group. All respondents answered to be exposed to reading materials and resources (print and non-print). Based on FLAT, there is a significant improvement between the pretest and posttest of the grade 7 students. There is a significant relationship between age, sex, socio-economic status, language spoken, and the functional literacy of the students. The Functional Literacy Assessment Tool (FLAT) was found to be effective for the students in terms of their reading skills, reading comprehension, and as a reading intervention. FLAT as an intervention program is highly effective.

As a result, the researcher made an action plan utilizing the FLAT as an intervention program to address the reading needs of those struggling readers.

Isinagawa ang Pilot test upang matukoy ang kabisaan ng biswal sa teksto. Inalam ang datos gamit ang mean at makabuluhang ugnayan ng kanilang marka sa pauna at pangwakas na pagtataya gamit ang T-test. Ang mga instrumento na ginamit sa pagaaral ay dumaan sa pagsusuri ng mga dalubhasa bago ito gamitin sa mga mag-aaral. Lumabas sa resulta ng datos na mabisa ang biswal na teksto dahil sa makabuluhang pagkakaiba ng iskor sa pauna at pangwakas na pagtataya. Natuklasan sa pag-aaral na mainam at malaking ambag ang pagkakaroon ng interes ng mga mag-aaral sa pagbasa upang mas madaling maisakatuparan ang pagsasagawa ng mga interbensiyon sa pang-unawa ng mga mag-aaral sa pagbasa, kaya iminumungkahi ng pag-aaral na unahin ang mga interbensiyon na makapupukaw sa interes ng mga mag-aaral sa pagbsa.

I wish to rest at colossus' deepest sleep of uncertainty; where my right is forever wrong.


And I neigh for bereavement of my good name's breath due to my blindness for truth; just like white is black though it makes me blue.


