Summer Montessori Program Tuition

Once you have reserved your space, you will be billed for the days and weeks you have chosen, regardless if your child attends on those days or not. Summer tuition may be paid in full by June 15th or you may pay in three equal installments over the course of the summer. Equal installments are due on the 15th of each month (June, July, and August). Drop-in charges will be billed at the end of each month for days and times outside your regular schedule.

Summer Montessori Program

The CHMS Summer Montessori Program is available Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. until 5:30 p.m. The tuition for our Summer Montessori Program is based on **weekly** rates which allows for flexibility in your schedule. You can customize your schedule to fit your needs, even if you only wish to sign up for a week here or a week there. We strongly encourage families new to CHMS to enroll their children for **at least two days a week** for the weeks they are attending.

Spots are filled on a first come, first served basis. Please register promptly to ensure your first choice. You will be charged for the space you reserve so make sure to choose your days carefully. If you need additional hours and/or days, please call the Office to reserve a space for your child. You will be charged the drop in rate of \$8.00 per hour, billed at the end of each month.

June

Farm to Table with Miss Darcie

June 17-20; 8:45am-12:30pm; 4-7yrs; \$130 (Mon-Thu)

Where does our food come from? This week will be about exploring how food makes its journey to our table. Students will learn how everything starts at the farm and how farmers help the animals and crops. We will spend some time exploring our own garden here at CHMS. Everyone loves a good field trip and these campers will get to visit a local grocery store and discuss how exactly the food gets from the farmer to the shelf, and finally we will eat the food in a meal prepped by the children!

Art – O – Rama with Miss Eve

June 24-27; 8:45am-12:30pm; 4-7yrs; \$130 (Mon-Thu)

This is going to be one fun-filled week of art! We will be experimenting with every medium we can think of: paint, clay, crayons, oil pastels, paper mache, chalk and much more! We will explore several famous artists as inspiration and the children will also be encouraged to come up with some of their own project ideas and given the opportunity to let their creativity guide them. Coding Club with Miss Kate (Guest Teacher)

July 8-11; 8:45am-12:30pm; 5-8yrs; \$130 (Mon-Thu)

We are partnering with a guest teacher and we are so excited! This class will allow your child explore the world of STEM this summer! Activities include block-based coding, everything Legos, and robotics. This class is hosted by Kate Wampler who has been teaching these same style classes throughout the public school system with great success. Little Chefs Culinary Institute with Miss Sue

July 15-18; 8:45pm-12:30pm; 6-10yrs; \$130 (Mon-Thur)

Kids love to cook . . . so that's what we're doing this week! From simple to complex we will explore how to safely and easily prepare a variety of foods with an emphasis on baking. Before, during and after we cook, we will learn and talk about where food comes from. Our first subject will be teaching children how wheat is ground and made into bread products. The students will use the bread dough to make pizzas. The class will also learn how to prepare a green salad, and bake and decorate a cake. By the end of the four days the children will have learned how to prepare an entire meal!

Fitness for Kids with Miss Heather

July 22-25; 8:45pm-12:30pm; 4-7yrs; \$130 (Mon-Thur)

Join Miss Heather to explore the positive impacts of health and exercise. Miss Heather is a certified CrossFit Kid Coach and is excited to bring that knowledge to a younger age-group in an engaging and appropriate way. Each day the class will focus on specific skills and on the final day all the movements learned will be combined into a fabulous field day! Included in the cost is a fitness "goodie bag" for each child.

Wild Water With Miss Amber

July 29-August 1; 8:45am-12:30pm 6-10 year olds \$130 (Mon-Thur)

This class ventures into the river system. Students will be interacting with a model structure that shows all aspects of the river, including a dam. Most of the model will be built as a whole class, but each student will have the chance to design or add their own piece into the river model. Participants should be comfortable working in a group setting, and come in clothing that can get wet and wear slip resistant shoes.
